

# **WEEK TWO – JUNE 2020 – K3**

Bible Story: I'm a Believer (Faith Is . . .) • Hebrews 11:1-12:3
Bottom Line: You can know Jesus even though you've never seen Him.
Memory Verse: "Faith is being sure of what we hope for. It is being sure of what we do not see." Hebrews 11:1 (NIrV)
Life App: Faith—Trusting in what you can't see because of what you can see
Basic Truth: I can trust God no matter what

**Summary:** In Week Two, we head to Acts 9:1–9 and meet a man named Saul, also known as Paul. Paul was on his way to arrest and persecute followers of Jesus. But Jesus had other plans for Him. Jesus stopped Paul on his journey and told him about his new mission. In a moment, Paul went from believing that Jesus was a false–teacher to believing that Jesus was the Son of God and Savior of the world.

# **OPENING DISCUSSION**

### 1. Icebreakers / Zoom SetUp

### What to ask:

- 2 people share: What has been the best thing you have done this week?
- 2 people share: What's one thing you miss being able to do right now?
- Leader share: What is one thing you look forward to during this Zoom call?
- Have kids grab some coloring utensils and paper + ask kids to draw their favorite season and favorite thing during that season.
- When they're finished, ask kids to share what they drew.
- Lead them in a discussion about how they know that seasons change.
  - What do they see that indicates a season change?
  - What about smells or sounds of season change?

### What to expect:

• Leader: Set healthy standards for what this group time will look like, how much time you'll spend just catching up, and how much time you'll be engaged with the discussion questions -- NOTE: you want to prompt them to watch the weekend message BEFORE this call so they understand what is being talked about.

### Recap the Weekend:

- Leader: Recap the story
