ENGAGE CHILDREN'S HEARTS THROUGH A DYNAMIC AND INTERACTIVE WORSHIP, BIBLE STORY, AND PRAYER EXPERIENCE IN A LARGE GROUP SETTING.

WORSHIP

WHAT YOU NEED: Paperclip "Memory Verse Card" in your Bible at Deuteronomy 31:6, NIV. You need a music player and this month's worship song, "Super Duper Kid," which is included in your monthly files. The dance moves video for "Super Duper Kid" is available on the Very Big Things Dance Moves DVD, at OrangeKidsMusic.com, or in your media package if you subscribe. You will also need "Very Big Things," which is available on the Very Big Things CD, iTunes®, and Spotify®. The dance moves video for this song is available on the Very Big Things Dance Moves DVD and at OrangeKidsMusic. com.

WORSHIP LEADER: "Welcome, everyone! Do you know what time it is? It's worship time! Let's stand up and sing to God. Remember, **God made me**, and God made you. He will help you be a super duper kid! Stand up and sing this out.

Lead children in singing "Super Duper Kid," this month's worship song.

"I love worshipping with you. This month, we're learning that **God made me to do big things. Who made you to do big things?**"

CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER: "God made me to do big things."

WORSHIP LEADER: "You got it! The Bible teaches us to 'Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid. For the Lord your God goes with you,' Deuteronomy 31:6. Let's say the verse with the motions together."

CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER: "'Be strong and courageous (cross fists over chest). Do not be afraid (cross hands back and forth) . . . for the Lord your God (point up) goes with you,' (hands on hips) Deuteronomy 31:6." (Open hands like a book.)

WORSHIP LEADER: "Guess what? You don't have to be afraid because the Lord your God goes with you! He made you to do very BIG things! Let's sing this out together.

Lead children in singing "Very Big Things."

"With God, you can do very big things! It's true. Remember, **God made me** and you, and He loves us, so much. One more time, **who made you to do big**

BIBLE STORY

God made me to do big things anywhere.

CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER: "God made me to do big things."

INTRO SKETCH

WHAT YOU NEED: Superhero theme music and Super Kids costume for Host

WHAT YOU DO: Cue the superhero music to the desired track on a phone or other music playing device.

Play the superhero theme music.

The Host enters in costume, very excited.

HOST: ("Hi, friends! It's me Super [your name]! Check out my super cape! When I'm a Super Kid, I can do amazing things. Like last week, we went to my aunts' house, and she lives three whole hours away. That's super-far.

"My aunt was making dinner for the family. But while she was cooking, I heard someone who needed help! It was my little cousin. So, I put on my super cape and dashed to the scene.

Run to the other side of the stage, cape flying

"First, I sang him a song to make him happy. (*Sing with the hand motions*.) "The itsy, bitsy spider went up the water spout. Down came the rain and washed the spider out!

"After that, I played a really cool game with him. (Cover and uncover you eyes.) "Peek-a-boo! Peek-a-boo!

"Oh, and then I could tell he was sleepy, so I gave him his favorite pacifier! And by the time my aunt was done cooking, my cousin was fast asleep. I'm glad I was able to help my cousin! I guess you can be super anywhere, even at your aunt's house that's so far away! I'm off to help someone else. See you later, super friends!"

The Host exits, cape flying.

BIBLE STORY

WHAT YOU NEED: Bible, table, and shepherd's staff; Optional Story Images

WHAT YOU DO: Preset the table in the center of the storytelling area.

The storyteller enters carrying a Bible.

STORYTELLER: "Hello, friends! I'm [your name], and it's time for a true story from the Bible! Are you ready to hear it? (*Pause*.)

Hold up the Bible and lay it open on the table.

"Awesome! Today's true Bible story is about someone who did a really big thing! His name was David. What was his name?"

(Option: Display Story Image W2 01)

CHILDREN: "David!"

STORYTELLER: "Yes! David was a shepherd who took care of his father's sheep.

Hold up the shepherd's staff.

"David made sure the sheep had green grass to eat and clean water to drink. He watched over them and kept them safe. But one day, while the sheep were asleep, a BIG lion came near them. Can you pretend to be a lion and roar with me? On the count of three, everyone roar like a lion! One, two, three!"

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "Roar!"

(Option: Display Story Image W2 02)

STORYTELLER: "Great job! The lion snuck up to the sheep and took one away in his mouth. OH, NO! What do you think David did? Everyone say, 'Tell us!'"

CHILDREN: "Tell us!"

STORYTELLER: "David stood up! He knew he needed to rescue the sheep, but that was a big job. He was far away in a really big field all alone.

(Option: Display Story Image W2 03)

"But David knew he wasn't really alone. God was with him and made him to do big things. That gave David the courage to save the sheep. God helped David be strong and brave. David ran to the lion and saved the sheep! Everyone say, 'Yay, David!'"

(Option: Display Story Image W2 04)

CHILDREN: "Yay, David!"

STORYTELLER: "The Bible teaches us that we can be strong and courageous because God is with us. God was with David, and God made David to do big things like save the sheep.

"God is with us, and He made us to do big things, too. He is with us at the park, on the playground, at night when we go to sleep. No matter where we are, we can remember that God is with us and made us to do big things.

"Tell me, who made you to do big things?"

CHILDREN: "God made me to do big things!"

STORYTELLER: "That's the truth, friends. Let's pray. Let's close our eyes and talk to God together."

PRAYER

STORYTELLER: "God, You are an awesome, big, and loving God. Thank You for helping David be brave and save the sheep. We know You can help us do big things! We love You so much. In Jesus' name we pray, amen.

"Thanks, friends! I'll see you next time. Bye!"

The Storyteller exits with the Bible and shepherd's staff.

OUTRO SKETCH

What You Need: No supplies needed.

The Host enters, still in costume and smiling.

HOST: "Wow! Wasn't that an awesome, TRUE story about David? God was with David and made him to do big) things, even far away in the field. And God made me and you to do big things anywhere, too! I think I got the story. If you got it, let me see both thumbs up. (*Pause*.)

"Awesome! I'm so glad that God was with me when I was far away at my aunt's house, so I could help my baby cousin. Whatever the day brings, **God made me**, and God made you! He made us all to do BIG things! **Who made** you to do big things?"

CHILDREN AND HOST: "God made me to do big things."

HOST: "Yes, He did! See you later, Super Friends! Here I go!"

Host exits, running with cape like a superhero.
