**BIBLE STORY**

God made me to do big things.

**DAVID AND GOLIATH**  
**1 SAMUEL 17:1-50**

**MEMORY VERSE**

“Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid . . . for the Lord your God goes with you.”

**DEUTERONOMY 31:6, NIV**

**KEY QUESTION**

Who made you to do big things?

**BOTTOM LINE**

God made me to do big things.

**BASIC TRUTH**

God made me.

**LARGE GROUP**

ENGAGE CHILDREN’S HEARTS THROUGH A DYNAMIC AND INTERACTIVE WORSHIP, BIBLE STORY, AND PRAYER EXPERIENCE IN A LARGE GROUP SETTING.

**WORSHIP**

**WHAT YOU NEED:** Paperclip “Memory Verse Card” in your Bible at Deuteronomy 31:6, NIV. You need a music player and this month’s worship song, “Super Duper Kid,” which is included in your monthly files. The dance moves video for “Super Duper Kid” is available on the Very Big Things Dance Moves DVD, at OrangeKidsMusic.com, or in your media package if you subscribe. You also need “Anything at All,” which is available on the Very Big Things CD, iTunes®, and Spotify®. The dance moves video for this song is available on the Very Big Things Dance Moves DVD and at OrangeKidsMusic.com.

**WORSHIP LEADER:** “Hey, friends! I’m so glad to see you here today. Do you remember what we’ve been learning all month long? Tell me, **who made you to do big things?**”

**CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER:** **“God made me to do big things!”**

**WORSHIP LEADER:** “Yes! You can do big things like make new friends, shine your light, and be a SUPER kid. Let’s sing ‘Super Duper Kid’ together!

*Lead children in singing “Super Duper Kid,” this month’s worship song.*

“I love that song, and I LOVE singing it with you. Do you remember our memory verse for this month? The Bible teaches us to ‘Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid. For the Lord your God goes with you,’ Deuteronomy 31:6. Let’s say it together with the motions.”

**CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER:** “‘Be strong and courageous (*cross fists over chest*). Do not be afraid (*cross hands back and forth*) . . . for the Lord your God (*point up*) goes with you,’ (*hands on hips*) Deuteronomy 31:6.” (*Open hands like a book.*)

**WORSHIP LEADER:** “God goes with you, and He can do anything, anything at all! Can God make a rainbow? (*Pause.*) Yes! Can God part the seas? (*Pause.*) He sure can. There’s nothing God can’t do. Let’s sing this out together.

*Lead children in singing “Anything at All.”*

“God can do anything. One more time, tell me, **who made you to do big things?**”





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**CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER:** "God made me to do big things."

**WORSHIP LEADER:** "Yes! God made me, and God made me to do big things."

## INTRO SKETCH

**WHAT YOU NEED:** Superhero theme music; Super Kids costume for the Host

**WHAT YOU DO:** Cue the superhero music to the desired track on a phone or other music playing device.

*Play Superhero music.*

The Host enters in full Super Kids costume, holding nose.

**HOST:** "Pee-yew! (Release nose.) Hi, friends! It is I, Super [your name]!"

*Wave hand in front of face.*

"There is a SUPER SMELL outside my house this morning. It's the trash cans outside my neighbor, Miss Kathy Sue's house. They've been sitting at the curb for days, and they are so stinky. Miss Kathy Sue can't bring in her trash cans because she hurt her foot and can't walk very far. That means she won't be able to bake cookies for all of the neighborhood children for the next couple of weeks!"

"Miss Kathy Sue is always doing things for other people. So, someone should do something for her. Someone like . . . my neighbor, Bob. I could ask him but actually, I think he's at work. Or maybe my neighbor, Inez. But I think I saw her leave to run errands. Who else could I ask? It's really stinky, and Miss Kathy Sue needs help. I'm not sure I can get all those trash cans and recycle bins by myself. But someone needs to help. I'll keep thinking on it! See you later, friends."

*The Host exits.*

## BIBLE STORY

**WHAT YOU NEED:** Bible; *Optional Story Images*

*The storyteller enters carrying a Bible.*

**STORYTELLER:** "Hello, friends! I'm [your name], and I'm so excited to be here today. It's time to hear a true story from the Bible. (Hold up the Bible.) Today's true story from the Bible starts with a Big. Mean. GIANT! Everyone say, 'WHOA!'"

**CHILDREN:** "WHOA!"

**STORYTELLER:** "His name was Goliath! What was his name?"

**CHILDREN:** "Goliath!"



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(Option: Display Story Image W3 01)

**STORYTELLER:** "Yes, Goliath. Can you guess who Goliath wanted to do mean things to? God's people, the Israelites! Every day, Goliath would tease the Israelites. *(in a sing-song voice)* Nah, nah, nah, nah! Who's going to challenge me?"

"But the Israelites were too scared. No one was brave enough to challenge the giant. That is, until a boy named David came along. What was his name?"

**CHILDREN:** "David!"

(Option: Display Story Image W3 02)

**STORYTELLER:** "Yes! David brought food to his older brothers. David was there when the giant came out to tease them again. And David thought surely one of the Israelite soldiers would challenge Goliath, but they were all afraid of him. Can you show me your scared face?"

*Make a scared face with the children.*

"They were so scared. So, David said, 'I'll do it!' Everyone was SO surprised. Can you show me your surprised face?"

*Make a surprised face with the children.*

"They were surprised because David was NOT a soldier. How could he challenge the giant? But David knew that God would help him be strong and courageous. So, he challenged the giant, Goliath.

"They tried to put armor on him. But guess what happened? The armor was too big and heavy! But it's okay that the armor didn't fit. David knew God would protect him and help him. David knew God made him to do big things.

(Option: Display Story Image W3 03)

"David took a slingshot and five smooth stones then went out to challenge the giant.

"So there was Goliath: *(in sing-song voice)* Nah, nah, nah, nah. Who's going to challenge me?"

"'Me!' David said. Goliath saw that he was just a boy! But remember, God was with David to help him do big things. So David took out his slingshot and said, 'Goliath! You may have all your big weapons, but God is WITH me!' Then David put one stone in the slingshot.

"Okay everyone, hold up your pretend slingshot like this. *(Demonstrate.)* Now twirl it in the air like this. *(Demonstrate.)* Great job! Put your pretend sling shots down now.

"David used his sling shot to shoot the rock. It hit Goliath and knocked that big giant to the ground! Everyone say, 'TIMBER!'"



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**CHILDREN:** "TIMBER!"

**STORYTELLER:** "Wow! David did it. He saved God's people from the mean giant. God made David to do a very BIG thing! Guess what? God made YOU to do big things, too! Tell me, **who made you to do big things?**"

**CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER:** "**God made me to do big things!**"

**STORYTELLER:** "Yes, He did! **God made me to do big things!** Let's close our eyes and talk to God about that."

## PRAYER

**STORYTELLER:** "Heavenly Father, thank You for the TRUE story of David doing such a BIG thing. Thank You for making us special to do BIG things, too. Nothing is too big for You. In Jesus' name we pray, amen."

"Thanks for listening, friends. See you later!"

*The Storyteller exits with the Bible.*

## OUTRO SKETCH

What You Need: No supplies needed.

*The Host enters, still in costume.*

**HOST:** "Wow! David did a really big thing! **God made me to do big things**, too. I think I got the story. If you got it, say 'Got it!' Get it?"

**CHILDREN:** "Got it!"

**HOST:** "Good! I know who can do something for Miss Kathy Sue . . . ME!"

*Strike a superhero pose with fists on hips.*

"I might have to make two trips to get all those trash and recycle cans put away, but I can do it! Whatever the day brings, **God made me to do big things**, and you can, too! So here I go to save the day. See you later, super kids!"

*Host exits with cape flying behind.*
