## BIBLE STORY

We can celebrate that God made me to do big things.

## KEY QUESTION

Who made you to do big things?

## BOTTOM LINE

God made me to do big things.

## BASIC TRUTH

God made me.

## LARGE GROUP

ENGAGE CHILDREN’S HEARTS THROUGH A DYNAMIC AND INTERACTIVE WORSHIP, BIBLE STORY, AND PRAYER EXPERIENCE IN A LARGE GROUP SETTING.

## WORSHIP

**WHAT YOU NEED:** Paperclip “Memory Verse Card” in your Bible at Deuteronomy 31:6, NIV. You need a music player and this month’s worship song, “Super Duper Kid,” which is included in your monthly files. The dance moves video for “Super Duper Kid” is available on the Very Big Things Dance Moves DVD, at OrangeKidsMusic.com, or in your media package if you subscribe. You also need “Anything at All,” which is available on the Very Big Things CD, iTunes®, and Spotify®. The dance moves video for this song is available on the Very Big Things Dance Moves DVD and at OrangeKidsMusic.com.

**WORSHIP LEADER:** “Friends, can you believe it’s already the LAST week of the month? We’ve had so much fun learning that **God made me to do big things! Who made you to do big things?”**

**CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER:** “**God made me to do big things.”**

**WORSHIP LEADER:** “You’ve got it! God made you to be a super-duper kid! Let’s sing this out.

*Lead children in singing “Super Duper Kid,” this month’s worship song.*

“With God’s help, you can share and forgive and be a super-duper kid! With God, you can do BIG things! **Who made you to do big things?”**

**CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER:** “**God made me to do big things.”**

**WORSHIP LEADER:** “That’s the TRUTH! We’ve been learning an awesome verse about how God will help us do big things. Let’s say it together!”

**CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER:** “‘Be strong and courageous (*cross fists over chest*). Do not be afraid (*cross hands back and forth*) . . . for the Lord your God (*point up*) goes with you,’ (*hands on hips*) Deuteronomy 31:6.” (*Open hands like a book.*)

**WORSHIP LEADER:** “Friends, you can ALWAYS trust God and remember that **God made me**. There’s no giant too big, no mountain too tall. God can do anything, anything at all. Let’s sing this out.

*Lead children in singing “Anything at All.”*





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**WORSHIP LEADER:** "There's nothing so big that God can't handle it. Remember, God goes with you and **God made me to do big things!**"

## INTRO SKETCH

**WHAT YOU NEED:** Superhero theme music; Super Kids costume for Host; table; bubble machine; box of sidewalk chalk; and soccer ball

**WHAT YOU DO:** Set the table in the middle of the storytelling area. Place the bubble machine, sidewalk chalk, and soccer ball on the table. Cue the superhero music to the desired track on a phone or other music playing device.

*Play the superhero theme music.  
The Host, very excited, walks out in the Super Kids costume.*

**HOST:** "Hello there, friends! It is I, Super [your name]."

*Put both hands up to one eye like a periscope.*

"With my super eyes, I can see so many friends! Have you ever made a new friend? Maybe there's a brand-new kid who just moved in on your street. Let's say you see him playing outside, but he looks sad all by himself. I mean, it's okay to play alone sometimes. But don't you like to play with friends? (Pause.) Me, too!"

"You know what I would do? As Super [your name], I would show up with a bubble maker. Check this out!"

*Turn on bubble machine.*

"Wouldn't it be so fun to pop bubbles with a new friend?"

*Turn off bubble machine. Pick up sidewalk chalk.*

"Oh, I know! You could share your sidewalk chalk. I LOVE drawing with this stuff."

*Put down chalk and pick up the soccer ball.*

"Or what about soccer? It's NO fun to kick the ball around by yourself. You could invite a new friend to play soccer with you! Introducing yourself to a new friend is a BIG thing to do, but I know God would help you. See you in a little while, friends."

*The Host gathers up the soccer ball, chalk, and bubble machine and exits.*

## BIBLE STORY

**WHAT YOU NEED:** Bible, music player, and dance music; *Optional Story Images*

**STORYTELLER:** "Hello, friends! I'm [your name], and it's time to hear a true story from the Bible!"

*Hold up the Bible and lay it open on the table in the center of the storytelling area.*



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*(Option: Display Story Image W5 01)*

"Does anyone remember who we've been talking about all month long? His name starts with a 'D.' *(Pause.)* Yes, David! Our story today starts with David dancing! Everyone on your feet. Show me your best dance moves.

*Play dance music for 30 seconds.*

"Wow, you've got some awesome dance moves! Have a seat friends.

"Now, you might be wondering, why was David dancing? Well, David danced because he was celebrating! Do you know WHO he was celebrating? *(Pause.)* God! David danced as a way to praise and thank God. David knew that God made him to do BIG things!

"What big things did David do? Well, let's play a game and see if we can remember. I'll ask you some questions about David, and you shout out the answer. Are you ready? Question number ONE!

*(Option: Display Story Image W5 02)*

"When David was a shepherd watching his flock of sheep, an animal came and took one of the sheep!

"Was it a giant octopus?

*Swing arms like an octopus.*

"Was it a mighty eagle?

*Flap arms like wings.*

"Or was it a lion?

*Hold hands up like paws and ROAR!*

"What's the right answer? Shout it out, everyone. *(Pause.)* Yes, a lion! You are correct. Okay, here's Question Two. David did something really big that other people were afraid to do. Was it . . .

*(Option: Display Story Image W5 03)*

"Take everyone some pizza?

*(singing tune of "Do You Want to Build a snowman" from Frozen)* "Did he wanna build a snowman?

"OR did David challenge a great, big giant named Goliath?

"Which one? Shout it out? *(Put a hand to your ear, then nod.)* If you said, 'Challenge the giant, Goliath,' you are right! God made David to do big things, and he knocked down the giant! Okay, last question.

*(Option: Display Story Image W5 04)*



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"When David became king, he helped someone.

"Did David help a (*hop up and down*) kangaroo?

"Did David help a woman cross the road?

"Or did David help Jonathan's son, Mephibosheth?

"What's your answer? Shout it out! (*Put hand to ear, then nod.*) That's right! God made David to do big things, and he took care of Mephibosheth! Great playing, everyone.

"God made David to do so many big things, and that's why David celebrated and praised God by dancing and making music and singing songs! David praised God because he wanted to say thank you.

"Now, raise your hand if you think God made you to do big things, too. (*Pause.*) Wow, so many hands! And you are right. God made us to do big things. Which means, we can dance, too! Tell me, **who made you to do big things?**"

**CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "God made me to do big things!"**

**STORYTELLER:** "Yes, it's true! God made you and **God made me. God made me to do big things!**

"Okay friends, it's time to pray. Let's close our eyes and talk to God together."

## PRAYER

**STORYTELLER:** "God, thank You for David and all the true stories we can read about him in the Bible. Thank You for giving David BIG things to do. We know You have big things for us to do, too! We want to celebrate like David and say thank You! In Jesus' name we pray, amen.

"Awesome job of listening, friends. Later gators!"

*The Storyteller exits with the Bible.*

## OUTRO SKETCH

What You Need: No supplies needed.

The Host enters still in Super Kids costume.

**HOST:** "Wow! God made David to do so many big things! And David praised God to say thank you. **God made me to do big things**, and I can praise God, too! I think I got the story. Did you get it? If you did, say, 'Got it!' Get it?"

**CHILDREN:** "Got it!"

**HOST:** "Good! Whatever the day brings, even if it's a brand-new friend, **God made me to do big things!** See you later, friends."

*Host exits waving to the children.*
