DISCUSSION QUESTIONS [TALK ABOUT GOD | BIBLE STORY REVIEW]

WHAT YOU NEED: No supplies needed

WHAT YOU DO: Ask:

- How can our words make a difference in the world or someone's life? (our words can make a positive or a negative difference to someone. Discuss the importance of choosing to build people up.)
- How can our attitude make a difference in someone's life? Encourage kids to give an example of how your attitude can make a difference.
- What can keep us from thinking we can make a difference?
- How can you make a difference right now?

BIBLE STORY EXTENSION [TALK ABOUT GOD | BIBLE STORY REVIEW]

WHAT YOU NEED: "Making a Difference Cards" Activity Page, markers, "Blank Cards" Activity Page, Bibles

WHAT YOU DO:

- Review the Bible story. Consider asking:
- What do we know about Timothy?
- What do you think Timothy's gifts were? (Prompt kids by asking what did Timothy do? What gifts would someone need to do what he did?)
- How did Timothy make a difference?
- Pair kids up.
- Give each team a "Making a Difference Card" and let them read the bio on the card.
- Encourage teams to talk with each other and identify what sparked their person to make a difference.
- Gather the group back together and let teams introduce the person on their card to the group.
- Prompt the teams to share how the kids on their cards are making a difference now.
- Ask:
 - How old do you have to be before you can start to make a difference?
 - What if you want to make a difference but you aren't sure where to start? What can you do?
- Give each kid a "Blank Card" Activity Page and let them create a "Making a Difference Card" for themselves.
- Encourage them to think of ways they can start making a difference right now. Refer back to the "Take a Snapshot" activity if they are stuck for ideas.

MAKE IT PERSONAL WITH PRAYER [PRAY TO GOD | PRAYER ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: (optional) "Making a Difference Cards" from the Bible Story Extension Activity

WHAT YOU DO:

- Ask: How can your prayers make a difference in someone else's life?
- Challenge kids to think of someone they could pray for this week.
 - Maybe they have a friend who is struggling in school or as a group, consider praying for one of the organizations you discussed in the Bible Story Extension Activity.
- Close by asking kids how you can pray for them this week. [Make it Personal] (Share an age-appropriate prayer request you may have and ask the kids to pray for you this week)
