"IYKYK THE WORD" (IF YOU KNOW YOU KNOW)

SCRIPTURE:

- James 1:19-27

TOPIC:

- The Word, Believe, Faith, Listening, and Doing

MAIN POINTS:

- Be planted in the Word, that you may recognize it.
 - Quick to Listen = Slow to Speak
 - Hearing vs. Understanding, and valuing the difference
 - Roots hold you firm to the foundation that you can be planted on
 - Real listening takes effort and action

GOAL OF TRIBES:

- To help students understand how to be rooted in the Word, have a firm foundation, and be able to hear and walk in the life God calls them.
- From trials to temptation, we get through it all by what our foundation is, being rooted in who Christ is, and every word He says.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What's one thing in your life that you have listened to again and again but can't seem to do? (*i.e. told to do my chores again and again can't seem to do it, math problems, etc.*)
- How does it make you feel when you know it but don't do that thing?
- How can the Word of God be something we can count on?
- What does it look like for you to be "rooted" in the Word of God?

- What are 3 ways you can be "planted" in the Word for the rest of April? Who is going to walk it out with you? What are the steps?
