TODAY'S KEY QUESTION

What are you hoping for?

TODAY'S BOTTOM LINE

MONTHLY LIFE APP

Hope—Believing that something good can come out of something bad

BASIC TRUTH

I can trust God no matter what.

OPENING ACTIVITY

WHAT YOU NEED: Sheets of Paper

WHAT YOU DO:

- Form two teams.
- Guide half of the kids on each team stand on one side of the meeting area and the remaining kids on the opposite

side—ideally, about 20 feet apart.

- Give teams on one side of the room two t-shirts each.
- Explain that the kids with the shirts will begin by placing one shirt on the floor then stand on it.
- From that point on, their feet must not come into direct contact with the floor unless standing on a shirt until they reach the other side.
- In order to take a step toward their team on the other side of the room, they must place the second shirt on the floor in front of them.
- While standing on the second, they must pick up the first then lay it down in front of them to take a third step.
- Continue in this way until they reach their team on the other side of the room.
- When a kid reaches their team, they can hand off the shirts to the next kid who will then repeat the same process.
- The first team to have all kids completely switch sides wins.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"That was a challenging way to get across the room. If the floor had been muddy, your mom would have appreciated that you kept your shoes clean. Unless, of course, those were your dad's best shirts you were walking on! [Transition] In our Bible story today, some people let their clothes get walked on. But no one got in trouble. In fact, people were cheering them on. Let's go find out about it."

Lead your group to the Large Group area.

CREATING A SAFE PLACE TO CONNECTED 25 MINUTES

MADE TO CONNECT

an activity that invites kids to share and collaborate with others while growing their understanding

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TAKE A SNAPSHOT [LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: Paper, markers

WHAT YOU DO:

- Pair up the kids. (girls with girls; boys with boys)
- Sit with one partner facing the back of the other.
- Give paper and a marker to the kids in the front.
- Tell the kid in back to use their finger to "draw" something on the back of the kid in front of them that reminds them of Easter.
- Without either of them speaking, the kid with the paper draws what they think it is on a piece of paper.
- Switch several times.
- Share drawings with the group and let kids tell the group what makes Easter special to them.



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DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

[TALK ABOUT GOD | BIBLE STORY REVIEW]

WHAT YOU NEED: No supplies needed

WHAT YOU DO:

Ask:

- What are some hard situations you or other kids your age have gone through?
- What does it feel like when you're facing a tough situation and you can't see or understand what God is doing in it?
- What does it look like for a kid your age to trust God when going through a problem that feels hopeless?
- Why does it give us hope to know that God is ALWAYS working out God's plans and will NEVER stop?

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CREATING A SAFE PLACE TO CONNECT
25 MINUTES

MADE TO REFLECT

an activity that creates space for personal processing and application

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MAKE IT PERSONAL WITH PRAYER [PRAY TO GOD | PRAYER ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: Bible

WORSHIP

WHAT YOU DO:

- Close by leading kids in a responsive prayer.
- Read aloud Psalm 145:13.
- Ask kids to respond by saying, "Hosanna" each time you pause.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"Dear God, Your kingdom is a kingdom that will last forever, (pause) and your rule will continue for all time to come. (pause) The Lord will keep all his promises. (pause) He is faithful in everything he does. (pause) In Jesus, name, amen."
