

ANTHEM TRIBE TALKSHEET

"AMAZING GRACE"

SCRIPTURE:

• John 21:15-17

TOPIC:

Grace

MAIN POINTS:

 Because of the resurrection, we have redemption. Your guilt is no match for God's grace

GOAL OF TRIBES:

 To help students understand that God's grace should change us.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What's something you got in trouble for when you were a little kid?
- Share an example of a person from a movie, book, or Bible story where you saw the main character change after doing something wrong.
- How do you handle guilt when you experience it? (denial, blame others, ignore it, etc.)
- Read 1 Peter 4:8. Years after Peter denied Jesus and then was forgiven by Jesus, Peter wrote this letter to his friends. How does knowing Peter's story change the way you read this verse?
- Knowing how Jesus responded to Peter after his experience with denying Him, what do you think Jesus would say to a teenager who has done something wrong? Is it easy or difficult to believe that's what Jesus would say to you?
- Think about an area of your life where you have felt guilt. Don't say it out loud. Who is one person you could share that with who would encourage you and remind you of God's grace for you? (Leader note: Give students 10-15 seconds to identify this area in their own mind, but do not encourage them to admit guilt in group.)
- DON'T MISS THIS: Do you feel like our small group is a place where you can show up and speak up when you feel guilt? Why or why not?
