GROUP TIME 1

- **Welcome and take tags**
- **Game: Pass the Egg (Hot Potato Style)**
 - Gather kids into a circle and hand each child an egg (all your eggs should be the same color)
 - Inside one egg, place a marble
 - Say "GO" and have kids pass their eggs to the person on their left and keep them moving until the leader says "STOP"
 - The person who ends up with the egg containing the marble will answer a question
 - Once that person has answered, play another round
 - Here are a list of questions you could ask:
 - What is your favorite Easter candy?
 - What is your favorite color?
 - What are you doing this afternoon after church?
 - Does your family have any Easter Day traditions?
 - Do you like getting dressed up for Easter?
 - **How many Easter Eggs do you think you could pick up in 30 seconds?**
 - ****PLEASE DO NOT ASK ANY QUESTIONS REGARDING THE EASTER BUNNY, OR ASK WHETHER THEY GOT SOMETHING FROM THE EASTER BUNNY**
- **Large Group Time**
 - Please sit in WITH your grade level during the Large Group time. There will be games you may need to help with. Also, please be present and engaged in worship and the teaching, helping redirect kids if they are getting too rowdy.

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GROUP TIME 2

DURING THIS TIME, WE WANT TO BE SUPER INTENTIONAL WITH CONVERSATIONS AND BE AWARE OF ANY KIDS WHO WANT TO MAKE ANY TYPE OF STEP IN THEIR FAITH

- If you've heard the Easter story lots of times already, what's something that stuck out to you today in particular? Is there anything you heard that you hadn't really thought about yet? What was your favorite part?
- Easter is about celebrating Jesus' resurrection? This gives us HOPE and certainty that God/Jesus loves us. How many of you believe that Jesus loves you? How has Jesus shown His love for you?

- **PRETEEN**
