BIBLE STORY

On days three and four, God made the land, plants, sea, sun, moon, and stars.

**LAND, PLANTS, SEA
& SUN, MOON, STARS
GENESIS 1:9-19**

MEMORY VERSE

"God saw everything he had made. And it was very good."

GENESIS 1:31, NIRV

KEY QUESTION

Who made everything?

BOTTOM LINE

God made everything.

BASIC TRUTH

God made me.

LARGE GROUP

ENGAGE CHILDREN'S HEARTS THROUGH A DYNAMIC AND INTERACTIVE WORSHIP, BIBLE STORY, AND PRAYER EXPERIENCE IN A LARGE GROUP SETTING.

WORSHIP

WHAT YOU NEED: Paperclip "Memory Verse Card" in your Bible at Genesis 1:31, NIRV. You need a music player and this month's worship song, "Things I See," which is included in your monthly files. The dance moves video for "Things I See" is available on OrangeKidsMusic.com or in your media package if you subscribe. You also need "All Good," which is available on the All Good album on iTunes®, Spotify®, and OrangeKidsMusic.com. The dance moves video for this song is available at OrangeKidsMusic.com.

WORSHIP LEADER: "Yay, it's time for worship! Are you excited? Let's stand up and sing because God deserves all of our praise. God made you, and **God made me. God made everything. Who made everything?"**

CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER: "**God made everything.**"

WORSHIP LEADER: "That's right. God made all the things we see. Sing this with me.

Lead children in singing "Things I See," this month's worship song.

"That was fun! Tell me, **who made everything?"**

CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER: "**God made everything.**"

WORSHIP LEADER: "Yes! The Bible teaches us that 'God saw everything he had made. And it was very good,' Genesis 1:31. Let's say our verse along with the motions."

CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER: "'God (*point up*) saw everything he had made. (*Binocular hands, look around*) And it was very good,' (*thumbs-up*) Genesis 1:31.'" (*Open hands like a book.*)

WORSHIP LEADER: "God saw everything He made, and it was ALL good! Sing this out with me.

Lead children in singing "All Good."

"That is a fun song to sing! We'll learn about ALL seven days of creation this month! Remember, **God made everything.**"



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INTRO SKETCH

WHAT YOU NEED: Table, clipboard, hand-written list, yellow flower, fruit bowl, oranges, apples, and one banana

The Host enters, very excited and carrying the clipboard.

HOST: "Hello there, friends! I'm [your name]. My friends and I have been doing scavenger hunts. I'm almost done with this one.

Hold up the list for the children to see.

"I have to find all kinds of yellow things. Last night, I found stars! Way up in the sky. Have you ever tried to count the stars? There are SO many. (*Singing*) 'Twinkle, twinkle little star. How I wonder what you are.' I love that song. And boy, there are SO many beautiful stars!

"Oh, and this morning when I woke up, I saw a BIG yellow thing in the sky. Can you guess what I saw? It makes everything so warm. Yes, the sun! (*Sing a line of a song about sunshine.*)

Look at the list.

"Oh, now I need to find the next yellow thing. Do you want to know what it is? (*Pause.*) I need to find a yellow flower. I love flowers. Do you see a yellow flower anywhere? (*Listen.*) Oh! Do you see it? Where is it?

Spin around to look, then spot the yellow flower.

"There's our yellow flower!

Walk over and pick it up to bring it back to the table.

"It smells so good! Now I just need to find one more thing. I need to find a yellow banana.

Look around and frown.

"Hmm. If I were a banana, where would I be? Somewhere nice and cozy, with all my friends.

Walk to the fruit bowl.

"Aha! The banana was hiding with all its fruit friends.

Hold up the banana.

"Thanks for helping me, everyone! You're awesome.

Return the banana to the bowl and leave the flower beside the bowl.

"I'll see you later."

The Host exits with the clipboard and leaves the flower and fruit bowl behind.



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BIBLE STORY

WHAT YOU NEED: Bible; fruit bowl and yellow flower from Intro Sketch; *Optional Story Images* from W1 and W2

The storyteller enters, carrying a Bible.

STORYTELLER: "Hello, friends! We're talking about all the WONDERFUL things God made! We know that God made the WHOLE world and everything in it. Everything. In the whole wide world. We can read about all God made in the Bible! (*Hold up your Bible.*) And remember, if it's in the Bible, it is true.

"On day one (*hold up one finger*) . . .

(*Option: Display Story Image W1 02*)

"God made the light and dark. And on day two (*Hold up two fingers*) . . .

(*Option: Display Story Image W1 03*)

"God made the sky above the water. But was God done yet? Nooo! On day three (*hold up three fingers*) . . .

(*Option: Display Story Image W2 01*)

God made land. Everyone, stomp on the floor. (*Demonstrate.*) Yes! Now there was land. And God gathered the waters together and called them 'seas.' Then, God created things to start growing on the land.

(*Option: Display Story Image W2 02*)

"God created fruit trees.

Pick up an apple and orange from the fruit bowl.

"And grass and flowers.

Pick up the yellow flower.

"God saw what He had made and God said, 'That's good!' (*Give two thumb-up.*) Everyone say, 'That's good!' with me."

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: (*two thumbs-up*) "That's good!"

STORYTELLER: "But God wasn't done! On day four (*hold up four fingers*), God made a light for the day and a light for the night. Hmmm, what light shines in the sky during the day? Do you know? It sounds like the word, fun! (*Pause.*) Yes, the sun!

(*Option: Display Story Image W2 03*)

"The sun shines in the sky during the day. You've got it! God made the sun to brighten up our days, help plants



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grow, and keep us warm. And He made a light for the night. What glows in the sky at night? It sounds like the word, spoon. (Pause.) Yes, the moon!

(Option: Display Story Image W2 04)

"The moon comes out at night. And God added lots and lots of little lights in the night sky. What are those called? It sounds like the word, cars. (Pause.) Stars! Yes! God filled the night sky with stars.

"On day four, God made the sun, moon, and stars! God saw what He had made and God said, 'That's good!' (Give two thumbs-up.) Everyone say, 'That's good!' with me."

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: (two thumbs-up) "That's good!"

STORYTELLER: "Now, let's remember everything God made! Count off the days with me. (Hold up one finger.) On day one . . .

(Option: Display Story Image W1 02)

"God made light and dark. (Hold up two fingers.) On day two . . .

(Option: Display Story Image W2 02)

God made sky over water. (Lead children to hold up three fingers.) On day three . . .

(Option: Display Story Image W2 02)

"God made land, plants, and sea. (Lead children to hold up four fingers.) On day four . . .

(Option: Display Story Image W2 03)

"God made the sun . . .

(Option: Display Story Image W2 04)

"and the moon and stars. Great job! God made ALL those things. **God made everything.** Tell me, **who made everything?"**

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "**God made everything!**"

STORYTELLER: "Yes, He did! God made the land, plants, and sea, the sun, moon, and stars, too. Let's close our eyes and talk to God to say, 'Thank You, God.'"

PRAYER

STORYTELLER: "Dear God, you are SO amazing! No one could do what you have done. You made the land, plants, and sea, and the sun, moon, and stars. You made EVERYTHING! Thanks for loving us so much and for sending your Son, Jesus, to be our friend forever. In His name we pray, amen.

"Friends, you are the best listeners ever! I'll see you later. Bye!"

The Storyteller exits with the Bible.



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OUTRO SKETCH

WHAT YOU NEED: Banana from Intro Sketch

The Host enters, smiling.

HOST: "Wow! God made the land and plants and sea. And God made the sun and moon and stars, too! **God made everything!** I think I got the story. Did you get it? If you did, say, 'Got it!' Get it?"

CHILDREN: "Got it!"

HOST: "Good! I'm so glad God made so many wonderful things for us to enjoy.

Pick up the banana.

"Hey! God made this yummy yellow banana! And I'm going to have it for my snack. See you next time, friends!"

Host exits with the banana while waving to the children.
