## **WORSHIP**

**WHAT YOU NEED:** Paperclip "Memory Verse Card" in your Bible at Genesis 1:31, NIrV. You need a music player and this month's worship song, "Things I See," which is included in your monthly files. The dance moves video for "Things I See" is available on OrangeKidsMusic.com or in your Media Package if you subscribe. You also need "Anything At All," which is available on the Very Big Things album on iTunes®, Spotify®, and OrangeKidsMusic.com. The dance moves video for this song is available at OrangeKidsMusic.com.

**WORSHIP LEADER:** "I'm SO happy to see you today! Why? Because it's time to sing and dance and worship God, the One who deserves all our praise. Did you know that **God made everything?** We've been talking about that all month long! Tell me, **who made everything?**"

#### CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER: "God made everything."

**WORSHIP LEADER:** "God is awesome! Stand up and sing.

Lead children in singing "Things I See," this month's worship song.

"Beautiful singing, friends! God made us and He loves us so. Who made everything?"

CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER: "God made everything."

**WORSHIP LEADER:** "The Bible teaches us that 'God saw everything he had made. And it was very good,' Genesis 1:31. Let's say it with the motions."

**CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER:** "'God (point up) saw everything he had made. (Binocular hands, look around) And it was very good,' (thumbs-up) Genesis 1:31." (Open hands like a book.)

**WORSHIP LEADER:** "Yes, **God made everything**, and it was VERY good! He can do anything, anything at all. Sing this with me!

Lead children in singing "Anything At All."

"What an awesome month we are having learning about God's creation! Thanks for worshipping with me."

# **INTRO SKETCH** WHAT YOU NEED: Sketch pad and colored pencils

**WHAT YOU DO:** In the sketch pad, draw a rock on page one, a centipede on page two, and a rainbow on page three.

The Host, very excited, walks in carrying the sketch pad.

**HOST:** "Hello there, friends! I'm [your name]. I just finished a GIANT scavenger hunt all over the neighborhood. Whew! We found rocks and birds' nests, flowers and bugs, and SO many things! I didn't want to forget any of the things we found. So, I made a book of drawings to remember them.

Open to the first page and show the rock to the children.

"There was this amazing rock that was super shiny! Wow!

Flip to the second page with the centipede and show the children.

"Oh, and we found a centipede. It had SO MANY LEGS! Can you imagine trying to walk with that many legs? How could you ever buy enough shoes? Ha-ha-ha!

Flip to the third page with the rainbow but don't show the children, yet.

"But the very BEST part was that it rained for a few minutes. Then . . .

Show the drawing to the children.

"We saw a beautiful rainbow in the sky! And it wasn't even on the list. Wow. So many colors! It was a blast! See you later, friends."

The Host exits with the sketch pad.

# **BIBLE STORY**

WHAT YOU NEED: Bible; Optional Story Images

The storyteller enters carrying a Bible.

**STORYTELLER:** "Hello, friends! We've been talking all month long about how **God made everything.** He really did. And you can read about all He made in the Bible. And remember, if it's in the Bible, it's true!

"Can you remember all the things God made? Count off the days with me.

Hold up the corresponding number of fingers with each day.

"On day one . . .

"God made light and dark. On day two (hold up two fingers) . . .

(Option: Display Story Image W1 03)

"God made the sky over the water. On day three (hold up three fingers) . . .

(Option: Display Story Image W2 02)

"God made land, plants, and sea. And on day four (hold up four fingers) . . .

(Option: Display Story Image W2 03)

"God made the sun . . .

(Option: Display Story Image W2 04)

"... and the moon and stars. (Hold up five fingers.) On day five ...

(Option: Display Story Image W3 03)

"God made fish and birds! And on day six . . .

(Option: Display Story Image W4 01)

"God made animals. Also on day six, God made His most SPECIAL creation. Drumroll, please. (Demonstrate.)

(Option: Display Story Image W4 02)

PEOPLE! Great job, everyone. You did it. You remembered everything God made. Do you know what God did AFTER He made everything? (*Hold up seven fingers.*)

"On day seven. . .

(Option: Display Story Image W5 02)

"...God stopped! (pause) God rested. (pause) God stopped to look around at all the beautiful things He had made.

(Option: Display Story Image W5 01)

"God saw the sun, the land, the plants, the sea, the birds, the fish, and the animals. God saw His most fantastic, amazing creation. . . people. And on day seven. . .

(Option: Display Story Image W5 02)



"God rested. God saw everything He had made and what did He say? God said, 'That's VERY good.' (*Give two thumbs-up.*) Everyone say, 'That's very good!'"

**CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER:** (two thumbs-up) "That's very good!"

STORYTELLER: "God made EVERYTHING. Now, let me hear it from you. Who made everything?"

#### CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "God made everything!"

**STORYTELLER:** "That's the truth. Light and dark, sky over water, land, plants, seas, the sun, moon, and stars, fish and birds, animals and people—ALL made by God! Wow! God is just amazing. Let's pray and tell God how amazing He is. Let's talk to God."

# PRAYER

**STORYTELLER:** "Dear God, wow! There is NO one like You. You made EVERYTHING! Every blade of grass, every cloud, every tiny flower, giant fish, and powerful animal. And you made us, every person here. Thanks for creating such a beautiful world and for creating us, God. We LOVE You. In Jesus' name we pray, amen.

"Friends, I'm just so, so glad God made YOU! Thanks for listening."

The Storyteller exits with the Bible.

## OUTRO SKETCH WHAT YOU NEED: Sketch pad from Intro

The Host enters, smiling with the sketch pad.

**HOST:** "Wow! God stopped to look at all the amazing things He made, and it was VERY good. I think I got the story. Did you get it? If you did, say, 'Got it!' Get it?"

#### CHILDREN: "Got it!"

**HOST:** "Good! I'm going to take a little rest and look at all the cool things we found on our scavenger hunt. See ya later, friends."

Host exits with the sketch pad while waving to the children.
