## WELCOME

Host has lots of energy as he or she welcomes everyone to [Name of Environment]. Host is relatable and inviting. Host can talk about something that happened culturally throughout the week like a big sports game, movie opening, a viral video on YouTube, etc. Host tells them how excited he or she is that they're there and briefly runs through what they can expect. This is especially helpful for first-time guests to make them feel like they know what's happening.

## OPENER

**HOST:** "Hey, hey, hey! Just another amazing day here in [Name of Environment]. It's the most wonderful time of year, isn't it?! I mean, Christmas is around the corner! I don't know about you, but I get so excited about not just getting presents but GIVING them—making them or buying them, wrapping them, and stacking them under our Christmas tree. In the spirit of the season, we have all these presents up on stage (points to stack of presents on stage). But these aren't just any presents, these are what two teams will need for our game this morning. Who wants to play Christmas Stack 'Em?

**SLIDE: CHRISTMAS STACK 'EM**

Host selects four volunteers (two teams of two).

"(To Volunteers) Alright, so I have some good news, and I have some bad news. I'll give you the bad news first. You won't be opening these presents.

I know . . . bummer. But the good news: if your team can use these presents and build the tallest present tower, you will win a fantastic prize for your small group. Awesome, right? Right. So, when I say go, run, grab a box, and begin building on the stage. You will have two minutes. At the buzzer, you must be able to take your hands off and let the tower stand freely. Whoever has the highest tower wins! Got it? Let's GO!"

**AUDIO: FUN CHRISTMAS MUSIC**

**OPTIONAL VIDEO (MEDIA PACKAGE): COUNTDOWN (5-MINUTE VERSION CUED AT 2 MINUTES)**

*If you're not using a screen countdown, set a timer on your phone for two minutes.*

*Commentate while teams build. Count down from ten at the end. Measure towers and declare a winner. Offer the winning team a Christmas-themed snack of some sort for their Small Group(s).*

*"(After the game) That was incredible! You all sure know how to stack your gifts. Well done, my friends! Now, let's all stand up and worship our amazing God together!"*

## WORSHIP

*Worship Leaders enter as Host exits.*

**WORSHIP LEADER:** “Hi, everyone! It’s great to be with you today. We have some fun Christmas songs to sing. This first one is about the angels who sang about Jesus, the newborn King. Let’s lift our voices and worship God together. Come on!

**AUDIO: “HARK THE HERALD ANGELS SING” / TRACK 6 FROM JINGLE JAM: SONGS FOR THE SEASON**

“Nicely done! I love to sing these songs that remind us what Christmas is all about. Before we continue in worship, everybody watch this.

**OPTIONAL VIDEO (MEDIA PACKAGE): LIVE LOUD VIDEO FROM GET REEL**

“We can share the love and joy of Christmas—not just with the words we say, but with the way we live each day. I want to share God’s love everywhere I go! Let’s sing about that now.

**AUDIO: “GO TELL IT” / TRACK 1 FROM GO TELL IT SINGLE**

**OPTIONAL VIDEO: “GO TELL IT” LIVE LYRICS OR DANCE MOVES MUSIC VIDEO**

“We read in Isaiah about the Messiah who was to come: ‘*And he will be called Immanuel.*’ (Isaiah 7:14b, NIV) ‘Immanuel’ means ‘God with us.’ I think it’s amazing that in this great, big world, God is ALWAYS with us. God is with you. God is with me. God is with your friends or family that live far away. God’s gift in Jesus was a promise to us that we are never alone. Let’s give thanks as we sing about the night Jesus was born.”

## COMMUNICATOR SCRIPT (STORY)

**SLIDE: THEME BACKGROUND**

*Communicator enters as Worship Leaders exit.*

### INTRODUCTION

**COMMUNICATOR:** “Hey, everyone! So glad that I can be with you today. I don’t know about you, but I love this time of year! Last week we talked a bit about some of your Christmas traditions, and a GREAT tradition that many of you had was driving or walking around your neighborhood and seeing the different lights and decorations people have put up where they live. And it seems like every year there’s that one house that just goes crazy with Christmas lights—like their electric bill must quadruple for the month of December. Any of you have a place like that near where you live? I see those hands! We have a few, too. I thought it’d be fun to do a quick internet search for extreme Christmas light designs. And . . . well, check THESE out!

**SLIDES: THREE TO FIVE IMAGES OF EXTREME HOUSE DECORATIONS**

*Communicator provides commentary throughout the images of extreme Christmas decorations. See “What You Do” below.*

“Those are intense, right?! It’s amazing what people will do to go out of their way to celebrate Christmas. Personally, I love it! It’s like you can’t look at these or drive past decorations in your neighborhood and NOT feel some sort of joy about the Christmas season, right? Of course, we know that Christmas isn’t about all the lights and presents and decorations, but you have to admit that Christmas lights just make you happy and look forward to Christmas morning.”

### TENSION

**COMMUNICATOR:** “But can I be honest for a second? In a season that’s so full of joy, why does it seem sometimes like joy can be the last thing we can find during Christmas? Maybe it’s the busyness of the shopping and parties and family gatherings. Maybe it’s a situation at home or at school that feels impossible and we’re unsure of the future. Or maybe life just isn’t going the way you expected it to go and you’re just not feeling too joyful right now. What then? How can we find joy and remember all that’s good, not just about the season of Christmas, but also what’s good about God?”

“First of all, it’s okay to be sad about things that happen to us. We need to feel our feelings, even at Christmas time. Second of all, it’s okay to have these questions. Life can be tricky, and God is more than big enough to handle even our toughest questions about life. On top of all that, while we might not always find the answers that we want, we have a great place to start: The Bible.

“Remember, the Bible was written by all sorts of people who experienced the power of God in their lives. God inspired people to write down those experiences so people like us can learn from them and discover God’s love for ourselves . . . including how we can find joy when life is hard. Let’s take a look at a couple of stories that talk about that.”

### TRUTH

**COMMUNICATOR:** “Last week we talked about a big promise God had made through a prophet named Isaiah. Before that, you might remember how in the beginning, out of love, God made an amazing world. But sadly, people turned away from God and the world became broken . . . the world needed a Rescuer. God made a plan to bless

the whole world through Abraham and the family who was going to come through him . . . you remember them, they were called . . . the Israelites. But over and over again, it seemed like the people were just resisting God and His plan for them. During the time of the kings, both the northern kingdom of Israel and the southern kingdom of Judah were conquered by foreign empires. But before they went into exile, and while they were there, God spoke to them through prophets about a Rescuer. And even though many people came back to what remained of Israel after captivity, I'm sure they had questions. Big questions. And to top it off, there was a long period of time when nothing happened. God made lots of promises about a Rescuer, but for hundreds of years, the Rescuer didn't come. But make no mistake . . . God was still working and getting ready to reveal what had been planned all along.

"Today, we find ourselves in the New Testament of our Bible. And during this time, God's people were ruled by yet another empire: the Romans. Honestly, it was hard to find a lot of joy. And for one couple, joy seemed especially hard to find at times. Let's check it out."

*Open the Bible to Luke 1:5 (NIRV) and read.*

*"Herod was king of Judea. During the time he was ruling, there was a priest named Zechariah. He belonged to a group of priests named after Abijah. His wife Elizabeth also came from the family line of Aaron."*

**SLIDE: STORY IMAGE 1 (ZECHARIAH AND ELIZABETH)**

"Zechariah and Elizabeth were Israelites living in Roman-occupied Israel. Zechariah had an important role. Did you catch it? (Allow for responses) Right! He was a priest. That meant one of his roles was to serve at the temple in Jerusalem when his group of priests were chosen . . . but we'll get to that in a moment. Okay, we know their names, but what were they like? Let's keep reading . . .

*Open the Bible to Luke 1:6-7 (NIRV) and read.*

*"Both of them did what was right in the sight of God. They obeyed all the Lord's commands and rules faithfully. But they had no children, because Elizabeth was not able to have any. And they were both very old."*

"Did you catch that? They were faithful followers of God! They obeyed God even when it was difficult. But did you hear the second part? It was a sad part of their story. They never had children. Not because they didn't want any. They couldn't have any. And now it seemed like they were too old. For them, this must have felt like an impossible situation.

"By the way, does this remind you of any other couple who we've talked about from the Bible?"

*Allow for responses.*

"Wow! That's a great memory! Yes, Abraham and Sarah!"

**SLIDE: STORY IMAGE 2 (ABRAHAM AND SARAH)**

"This story definitely makes us think of that story. And for Abraham and Sarah, we know what happened: God showed up when it seemed most unlikely. So let's keep reading and see what happened to Zechariah and Elizabeth.

*Open the Bible to Luke 1:8-10 (NIRV) and read.*

*“One day Zechariah’s group was on duty. He was serving as a priest in God’s temple. He happened to be chosen, in the usual way, to go into the temple of the Lord. There he was supposed to burn incense. The time came for this to be done. All who had gathered to worship were praying outside.”*

**SLIDE: STORY IMAGE 3 (JERUSALEM TEMPLE)**

“Like we said earlier, Zechariah had a really important role. It was his group’s time to offer the sacrifices in the temple in Jerusalem. And then Zechariah himself was chosen to do something important. He was chosen to go inside the space right next to where they experienced God’s very presence for centuries and burn incense. This was a special, once-in-a-lifetime honor.

“Well, if that wasn’t all, something quite unexpected happened while Zechariah was in there. Check this out!

*Open the Bible to Luke 1:11-12 (NlrV) and read.*

*“Then an angel of the Lord appeared to Zechariah. The angel was standing at the right side of the incense altar. When Zechariah saw him, he was amazed and terrified.”*

**SLIDE: STORY IMAGE 4 (ANGEL STANDING NEXT TO ZECHARIAH)**

“Okay, just so we’re on the same page here, it was not normal to have an angel begin speaking to you in the temple. I’m sure Zechariah was caught off guard and was a bit scared. But this angel arrived with a very special message for Zechariah . . .

*Open the Bible to Luke 1:13 (NlrV) and read.*

*“But the angel said to him, “Do not be afraid, Zechariah. Your prayer has been heard. Your wife Elizabeth will have a child. It will be a boy, and you must call him John.””*

“Woah! This WAS like Abraham and Sarah! Another older couple was being told that God would give them a child in their old age. On top of that, this child would also be special starting with his name: John. Check out what the angel said John would do.

*Open the Bible to Luke 1:16-17 (NlrV) and read.*

*“He will bring back many of the people of Israel to the Lord their God. And he will prepare the way for the Lord. He will have the same spirit and power that Elijah had. He will bring peace between parents and their children. He will teach people who don’t obey to be wise and do what is right. In this way, he will prepare a people who are ready for the Lord.”*

**SLIDE: STORY IMAGE 5 (FLASH-FORWARD OF JOHN THE BAPTIST AT THE JORDAN RIVER)**

“God had a special plan for this baby. But I’m sure Zechariah had a lot of questions. Honestly he didn’t really believe the angel’s words because they seemed SO impossible. An old man like him? A baby? Turned out that Zechariah didn’t believe it was possible. The angel told him that he would not be able to speak until John was born

because of his unbelief. And when Zechariah came out of the temple that day, he could only gesture to the people waiting outside. How would he, or anyone for that matter, know that God would come through on this one?

“Well . . .

**SLIDE: STORY IMAGE 6 (ZECHARIAH AND ELIZABETH PICTURE WITH PREGNANT BELLY)**

“It happened. Elizabeth became pregnant.”

*Open the Bible to Luke 1:25 (NirV) and read.*

““The Lord has done this for me,” she said. “In these days, he has been kind to me. He has taken away my shame among the people.””

“Now in another part of Israel . . . in a town called Nazareth which is in Galilee, Elizabeth’s cousin was having quite an encounter of her own. You might know her. Her name was . . . Mary. And just like Zechariah, God sent an angel to give Mary a message.”

**SLIDE: STORY IMAGE 7 (ANGEL SPEAKING TO MARY)**

*Open the Bible to Luke 1:28 (NirV) and read.*

““The angel greeted her and said, “The Lord has blessed you in a special way. He is with you.””

“I’m sure Mary also had all sorts of questions. Why is an angel visiting me? What have I done? Is this good news? Bad news? But the angel continued.

*Open the Bible to Luke 1:30-33 (NirV) and read.*

““But the angel said to her, “Do not be afraid, Mary. God is very pleased with you. You will become pregnant and give birth to a son. You must call him Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High God. The Lord God will make him a king like his father David of long ago. The Son of the Most High God will rule forever over his people. They are from the family line of Jacob. That kingdom will never end.””

“This was an absolutely incredible promise! God was sending the Rescuer, and Mary was going to be the Rescuer’s mother!

**SLIDE: STORY IMAGE 8 (FORESHADOWING OF OLDER MARY WITH JESUS)**

“For Mary, this would have been a confusing, seemingly impossible promise. After all, Mary was not married and was not ready to have children yet. How could God work all of this out?

“But the angel assured Mary that this would be the work of God, and that what God had promised would come true. And Elizabeth was already a living sign that God could do the impossible.

Open the Bible to Luke 1:38 (NirV) and read.

““I serve the Lord,” Mary answered. “May it happen to me just as you said it would.” Then the angel left her.’

**SLIDE: STORY IMAGE 9 (ANGEL LEAVING MARY)**

“Well, Mary went to visit Elizabeth, who was several months pregnant at this point. Mary wanted to see if what the angel had said was true. Immediately Elizabeth knew that God was doing a work in Mary’s life. As they discussed together, Elizabeth spoke to Mary.

Open the Bible to Luke 1:45 (NirV) and read.

““You are a woman God has blessed. You have believed that the Lord would keep his promises to you!’

**SLIDE: STORY IMAGE 10 (ELIZABETH AND MARY TALKING)**

“And Mary prayed one of the most famous prayers possibly in the whole Bible as a response. It seems like it was more a prayer song. Check out the beginning.

Open the Bible to Luke 1:46b-49 (NirV) and read.

““My soul gives glory to the Lord. My spirit delights in God my Savior. He has taken note of me even though I am not considered important. From now on all people will call me blessed. The Mighty One has done great things for me. His name is holy.’

**SLIDE: STORY IMAGE 11 (MARY PRAISING)**

“Mary stayed with Elizabeth about three months before returning home. Soon after, Elizabeth gave birth to a baby, John. Zechariah could speak again as soon as the baby was born. The whole town was amazed and filled with wonder!

**SLIDE: STORY IMAGE 12 (ZECHARIAH AND ELIZABETH WITH BABY, TOWNSPEOPLE GATHERED AROUND)**

“God turned sorrow into joy by making what seemed to be impossible, possible!”

**SLIDE: GOD’S BIG STORY TIMELINE**

**SLIDE: DECEMBER WEEK 2 TIMELINE IMAGE**

*If you’re making a timeline of printed images on your wall, take this moment to place today’s timeline image on the clothesline.*

## APPLICATION

**COMMUNICATOR:** “You know, this story is filled with moments that seem quite unlikely—impossible even. Elizabeth and Zechariah having a kid in their old age? Or Mary, an ordinary girl from Nazareth, chosen to be the mom to the Savior of the world?! Then you had the angel visits and God choosing humble people from the middle of basically nowhere to put an incredible plan into motion.

“When it comes to situations in our life though, it’s sometimes easy for us to believe that God should work this way or that way. Maybe we start to believe that God CAN’T do it like this or like that. But the Bible is filled with stories that prove how God can often make impossible things possible, leaving people in the wake who can only respond with amazement and wonder and joy at what just happened . . . and ultimately, this response isn’t to what happened, but to God who made it happen.

“Maybe you have something going on right now in your life—a friend thing, a family situation, a personal struggle—and your first instinct is to simply say, ‘THIS one is too big for God’ or ‘No WAY God can do anything with this one.’ But remember, God has a pretty long track record of doing impossible things. It doesn’t always mean that God will do them exactly the way you want to or how you ask, but it does mean that God can be trusted with what seems impossible. And no matter what is happening—Christmas time or any other time of the year—that’s enough to spark joy!”

**LANDING**

**COMMUNICATOR:** “As you head to groups, think about this question:

**SLIDE: KEY QUESTION**

**“What’s the most amazing thing you’ve ever seen?”** What was your reaction? Or the reaction of the people around you? How does that amazing thing compare to the moments we read together today? What do those moments tell you about God? Those are some big questions, so if you need help thinking through them, no worries! You’ll talk more about this in Small Group. Your Small Group Leader would love to chat with you about any of it! Before we head out, let’s pray and thank God for being powerful enough to do the impossible. Let’s pray.”

**SLIDE: THEME BACKGROUND**

*Dismiss students to their small groups.*

**AUDIO: PLAY HIGH-ENERGY MUSIC AS THE KIDS EXIT.**
