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LARGE GROUP

ENGAGE KIDS' HEARTS THROUGH A DYNAMIC AND INTERACTIVE BIBLE STORY, WORSHIP, AND PRAYER EXPERIENCE IN A LARGE GROUP SETTING.

AUDIO: PLAY HIGH-ENERGY MUSIC AS STUDENTS ENTER. SLIDE: THEME OPTIONAL VIDEO (MEDIA PACKAGE): THEME LOOP

Host enters . . .

OPTIONAL VIDEO (MEDIA PACKAGE): COUNTDOWN (30- OR 60-SECOND VERSION)

OPTIONAL VIDEO (MEDIA PACKAGE): THEME

WELCOME

Host has lots of energy as he or she welcomes everyone to [Name of Environment]. Host is relatable and inviting. Host can talk about something that happened culturally throughout the week like a big sports game, movie opening, a viral video on YouTube, etc. Host tells them how excited he or she is that they're there and briefly runs through what they can expect. This is especially helpful for first-time guests to make them feel like they know what's happening.

OPENER

HOST: "Hey, everyone! What a month it is! Can you believe Christmas is next week? But we don't have to wait until then to celebrate. We're celebrating God's best gift to us all month long. And in the spirit of giving, I have a few gifts I would like to give to a few of you in a game called The Big Give Away.

SLIDE: THE BIG GIVE AWAY

"This will be fun! I need SIX volunteers!

Host chooses six volunteers and introduces them to the rest of the group.

"Alright let's have you line up in a row, right here on the stage.

Six volunteers line up. Host asks the kid on both ends to guess the number in their head between 1-10. Whoever is closest is the start of the line and the game will begin with them.



"Alright, we'll start on THIS end (*pointing to the volunteer that guessed the number*) and work our way down the line. I'll choose a present and hand it to the first person. You may choose to keep it or pass it. If you keep it, you may open it and it is yours. If you pass it, the next person in line must make the same choice. Unfortunately, being at the end of the line here has its disadvantages. If everyone passes to you, you're basically stuck. Sorry! Make sense? Alright, let's begin!

AUDIO: FUN CHRISTMAS MUSIC

First person is handed a present. If they keep it, they open it. If they pass it, the second person decides to keep it or pass it. This happens until someone keeps it and opens it. Start each new present at the first person in line without a present yet.

"(After the game) Those are some special gifts! That was a lot of fun! Now let's stand up and sing some Christmas songs to worship God together!"



10 MINUTES

WORSHIP

Worship Leaders enter as Host exits.

WORSHIP LEADER: "Hi, everyone! I love to sing these Christmas songs with all of you. You might say I'm full of JOY to praise Jesus today. He is what this season is all about. We have so much to celebrate, so let's get started!

"One of the reasons I love this time of year is because of the gifts we give to our family and friends. But there truly is nothing like the love of God and the gift God gave us in Jesus! I love how this song tells the whole Christmas story. It reminds us of the greatest gift we've been given. Sing this with me.

"It's really cool to read in Matthew, chapter 2, how the wise men came to visit Jesus: 'When they saw the star, they were filled with joy. The Wise Men went to the house. There they saw the child with his mother Mary. They bowed down and worshiped him.' (Matthew 2:10-11, NIrV) I love that. When the wise men saw Jesus, they bowed and worshipped Him. That's like what WE'RE doing today. We sing as a way to honor Jesus and show how much we love Him. Sing this with me!"

COMMUNICATOR SCRIPT (STORY)

SLIDE: THEME BACKGROUND

Communicator enters as Worship Leaders exit.

INTRODUCTION

COMMUNICATOR: "Hey, everyone! Looks like you've been having a great morning so far. I loved seeing all of those gifts being shared, even if some of them were . . . not so great.

"In the spirit of gifts and giving, let me ask you—and be honest now—how many of you would say you enjoy giving gifts more than you enjoy receiving gifts? Anyone? (*notice response*) Ok, a few of you. That's great. I mean, there's something fun about picking out or even making a gift for someone, something that maybe they didn't even think about for themselves, and then seeing their face when they finally open it. It is pretty cool, right? Maybe someone has done that for you?"

Tell a personal story of a time when someone gave you a gift that you were not expecting and it really surprised you (in a good way), or when you did that for somebody else. Something like the following story. Optional: Use this story as a hypothetical situation.

I remember this one Christmas when I was in sixth grade. All I wanted was a Walkman . . . think of it like a really early version of listening to music on your smart phone—except it didn't make phone calls, take photos, connect to the internet, or anything other than play one cassette tape full of music at a time, though some could connect to radio stations. But since we didn't have smart phones or iPods or iPads, this was it. And I wanted one, and not just any Walkman. I wanted the Sony Sport, Waterproof, bright yellow Walkman with in-ear headphones. But I never thought my parents would get it for me. Honestly, I was just hoping for a simple Walkman of my own. By now, I'm sure you know where this is going, but . . . Christmas morning, under the tree was a present with my name on it. I tore into it, and yes! My parents surprised me with the Sony Sport! I spent the rest of the day listening to all of my cassette tapes. Best. Christmas. Ever!

TENSION

COMMUNICATOR: "But let's get serious for a moment. As great as that Christmas was, would it have still been great if my parents had only been able to get me a simple Walkman or didn't get me a Walkman at all? Of course, you probably only give gifts that people love! But truth be told, we don't always get what we asked for, or sometimes we give something the person already had, and sometimes even the gifts we absolutely LOVE on Christmas morning get lost under the bed or in a closet the next month. Too often I think this happens with the BEST gift that any of us has been given—Jesus.

"We take a whole month to celebrate that Jesus came. We have holidays that help us remember that Jesus came to make a way for us to be with God forever. We think about that gift during certain times of year or maybe on Sundays when we come to church. But how can we make a habit of remembering God's Big Give when Jesus came?

"That's a great question! Maybe it's one you've thought about before, or maybe you've never wondered that. And that's okay, too. With Christmas a week away, today is a great time for us to think about questions like this. And like we say at a lot around here, when we have questions, the Bible is a great place for us to start to find some answers especially when it comes to our questions about Jesus! Let's head there now and unwrap some answers . . . literally."

Communicator takes out first present.

TRUTH

COMMUNICATOR: "Okay . . . I have my first gift here. Let's see who this is for . . .

Communicator looks at the tag and reads out loud.

"To Caesar Augustus . . .

"Is Caesar Augustus here? Yeah . . . didn't think so. Well, how about we get one of you to help me open this and see what is inside!

Communicator calls on a volunteer to help them open the first present. They pull out the contents.

"So, what is it?

Volunteer responds. It's a long list of names. The volunteer may be confused. Volunteer can go back to their seat.

"Oh, you know what this is? This list of names is a census! A census is when the ruler of the country or region counted all of the people to see how many lived there. Check this out, and this list should make more sense.

Open the Bible to Luke 2:1, 3-4 (NIrV) and read.

"'In those days, Caesar Augustus made a law. It required that a list be made of everyone in the whole Roman world . . . Everyone went to their own town to be listed . . . So Joseph went also. He went from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to Judea. That is where Bethlehem, the town of David, was.'

"Okay, get it? Caesar Augustus, the ruler of the Roman Empire at the time was counting people to show his greatness and to see who should be giving him taxes. And to do so, everyone had to return to the place of their family's heritage. Enter Joseph. As in Mary and Joseph. Joseph was living in Nazareth, which was in northern Israel, but his family was FROM Bethlehem, which was in southern Israel.

"I have another present here. Let's check the tag.

Communicator looks at the tag.

"(*Reading tag*) To David. David? Like David and Goliath? That David? Okay, can someone else come and open this up since I'm guessing David is also not here.

Communicator chooses a volunteer to open the present, revealing a king's crown.

"A crown? Any thoughts on why he's getting a crown?

Allow for responses.



"Right . . . KING David. David was seen as the greatest king Israel ever had. Plus, did you catch what it said about Bethlehem, the town where Joseph was returning to for the census? It was the TOWN OF DAVID. This might have been a small place . . . but it was a place where royalty had come from!

"Alright, so because of the census, Joseph and a pregnant Mary traveled almost 70 miles from Nazareth to Bethlehem. That might be easy to read but that would have been a challenging trip.

"I have another present here . . . let's check the tag.

Communicator looks for the tag.

"(Reading tag) To Mary and Joseph? Hmmm . . . anyone want to open this one?

Volunteer opens the present and reveals the contents.

25 MINUTES

"(Communicator holds up strips of cloth) Any guesses on what these are? (Allow for responses) Or why there is hay in the bottom of the box? (Picks up a handful of hay) What a mess!"

"Let's keep reading.

Open the Bible to Luke 2:6-7 (NIrV) and read.

"'While Joseph and Mary were there, the time came for the child to be born. She gave birth to her first baby. It was a boy. She wrapped him in large strips of cloth (holds up the cloths). Then she placed him in a manger (holds up the hay). That's because there was no guest room where they could stay.'

"Ah, you see what this is? This is to show us how Jesus came into the world. The strips of cloth. The crib in the manger. It really was quite a mess. But it was into this mess, our mess, that God sent Jesus! Just imagine sending your only Son into this mess, but that's what God did for us!

"In fact, it looks like we have one more present here. Maybe this will help make some sense of everything . . .

Communicator searches for a tag and finds one.

"(Reading tag) To Everyone. Everyone? That is not very specific. Who can help me with this?

Communicator chooses a volunteer to open the present. They reveal the contents.

"(Looking into the box) I don't really see anything. Oh, there's a note here at the bottom . . . "

Communicator opens the note and has the volunteer read.

VOLUNTEER: "(*Reading the note*) Dear reader – I love this world so much. I created it and everything in it. Most importantly, I created you. I know this world needs rescue . . . I know YOU need rescue. And now, I am sending My Son, who I love so much. There is no greater way for Me to show you My love than to give you Him. His name is Jesus."

APPLICATION

COMMUNICATOR: "This was the first Christmas. Jesus is God's one and only Son, and God sent Him into this messy world to save us. There may be some pretty cool gifts you receive this next week, but make no mistake . . . THIS is how God gave us the GREATEST gift ever.

"Two thousand years ago, God gave the greatest gift. But now we have the opportunity in so many ways to show God's love and share it with others. And this is not just something we do in December. Anytime we have the chance to give gifts—actual presents or acts of service or just simply showing up for people who need a listening ear—we can show God's love to others. The birth of Jesus doesn't just matter during the Christmas season, it matters throughout the entire year. It matters in your classroom, on the basketball court or dance studio, it matters in your home and with your friends, it even matters for people you haven't even met yet. This is the GREATEST gift . . . all year long!"

LANDING

COMMUNICATOR: "Today as you head to Small Group, think about this question:

SLIDE: KEY QUESTION

"What are you excited about giving? How can what you give to others reflect how much God gave to you already? How can you share the love of Jesus this Christmas and all throughout the year? These are important questions to think about, and you'll have a chance to chat about them with your Small Group. Before we go to groups, let's pray and thank God for sending the greatest gift ever, Jesus! Let's pray."

SLIDE: THEME BACKGROUND

Dismiss students to their small groups.

AUDIO: PLAY HIGH-ENERGY MUSIC AS THE KIDS EXIT. SLIDE: THEME OPTIONAL VIDEO (MEDIA PACKAGE): THEME LOOP
