

SMALL GROUP GUIDE K-3

OPENING ACTIVITY:

Instruct that kid to whisper the lyrics into the ear of the person sitting next to them in line.

- Then that kid will whisper what they hear into the ear of the person sitting next to them.
- Continue on down the line until the message gets to the last kid. Ask the last kid to say what they heard out loud for everyone in the group to hear.
- If time allows, repeat until everyone has had a turn as the first in line to start the message.
- Have fun with your group, laughing about how the message might have changed as it carried from the first person in line to the last.
- Song lyric lines could include:
 - "Oh, what fun it is to ride on a one horse open sleigh."
 - "Joyful, all ye nations rise, join the triumph of the skies."
 - "Sing choirs of angels. Sing in exultation."
 - "Next year all our troubles will be miles away."
 - "Go tell it on the mountain over the hills and everywhere."
 - "A thrill of hope, the weary world rejoices."
 - "He was made of snow, but the children know how he came to life one day."
 - "While fields and floods, rocks, hills, and plains repeat the sounding joy."
 - "The stars in the sky looked down where He lay. The little Lord Jesus asleep on the hay."
 - "A new born king to see, pa rum pum pum pum. Our finest gifts we bring, pa rum pum pum."
 - "Feliz navidad. Prospero año y felicidad."
