LARGE GROUP

ENGAGE KIDS' HEARTS THROUGH A DYNAMIC AND INTERACTIVE BIBLE STORY, WORSHIP, AND PRAYER EXPERIENCE IN A LARGE GROUP SETTING.

AUDIO: PLAY HIGH-ENERGY MUSIC AS KIDS ENTER.

HOST: "Hey, everybody! I'm [your name], and I'm so glad we're all together at Mission Kids. This month, we're talking about something really important: confidence!

"Usually we talk about being confident when we're really good at something.

Put on the backpack.

"Maybe you were confident about a test because you studied hard.

Pick up the soccer ball.

"Or maybe you and your teammates were confident about your soccer game because you know you can work well together.

Pick up the video game controller.

"Or maybe you were confident that you could beat a level on your video game because you've played it SO much that you really know what you're doing!

Set down the items.

"It's good to feel that kind of confidence. But TRUE confidence comes from an even bigger reason than that. True confidence is this.

SLIDE: VIRTUE

OPTIONAL VIDEO (MEDIA PACKAGE): THEME TRANSITION TO VIRTUE

"It's living like you believe God is with you!

SLIDE: THEME

OPTIONAL VIDEO (MEDIA PACKAGE): VIRTUE TRANSITION TO THEME

"When you have THAT kind of confidence, you can 'raise your game' in a big way!

Hold up the video game controller.

"You can take on challenges in life because you know that you're not taking them on alone. God is always, ALWAYS with you!

"You know what? I've got a lot of confidence that you'll love today's game! It's our version of one of the very first video games that ever became really popular. It's called 'Pac-Man™.'

SLIDE: PAC-MAN SCREEN SHOT OR GAMEPLAY VIDEO (OPTIONAL)

"See that yellow circle guy? That's Pac-Man. His goal is to try to eat all the little dots to get points. But see those other little colorful creatures? Those are the ghosts who chase Pac-Man. If one of the ghosts catches him, he loses.

SLIDE: THEME

OPTIONAL VIDEO (MEDIA PACKAGE): THEME LOOP

"To play our real-life version of Pac-Man, I'll need some brave volunteers!

Choose one female Small Group Leader and two girls, as well as one male leader and two boys.

"We'll let the girls go first. [Female leader's name] will be Ms. Pac-Man™.

Give her the Pac-Man costume to wear.

"[Leader's name], you'll hop through the game board (reference the taped maze) and collect the little yellow dots. Make sure you pick up only the yellow dots, not the white ones! You can stick them here on this piece of paper.

Give her a dark-colored piece of construction paper.

(to the audience) "While she's doing that, [two girls' names] will be chasing after her to try to tag her. If one of them tags her, she has to go back to the beginning and start over. When time's up, we'll count how many dots she picked up.

10 MINUTES

"Now this game probably seems easy for [kids' names], but not very easy for Ms. Pac-Man. (Reference the leader.) So let's change things up a little bit. [Kids' names], you can't walk or run. You have to walk on your knees!

Give the knee pads to the two kids. Help them put the pads on. (The leader can help with this.)

Place the leader on one side of the taped maze, and the kids on the other side.

"All right, let's put 60 seconds on the clock. Here we go!

AUDIO: FUN 8-BIT VIDEO GAME MUSIC

OPTIONAL VIDEO (MEDIA PACKAGE): COUNTDOWN (60-SECOND VERSION)

If you're not using a screen countdown, set a 60-second timer on your phone.

Comment on the action as Ms. Pac-Man picks up dots while the kids chase her. Encourage the audience to cheer for everyone. When time's up, count how many dots the leader picked up.

"That was so fun! (to the leader) Ms. Pac-Man, it looks like you ate [number] dots. Nice work! Now it's the boys' turn.

Switch out the props so that the male leader is Pac-Man. Give the knee pads to the two boys. Explain that the leader should pick up the white dots, and give him a dark-colored sheet of construction paper.

AUDIO: FUN 8-BIT VIDEO GAME MUSIC

OPTIONAL VIDEO (MEDIA PACKAGE): COUNTDOWN (60-SECOND VERSION)

If you're not using a screen countdown, set a 60-second timer on your phone.

Again, comment on the action while the boys play. Encourage the audience to cheer. When time's up, count how many dots the leader picked up and determine which leader picked up the most dots.

Collect the props as you dismiss the volunteers to their seats.

OPTIONAL VIDEO (MEDIA PACKAGE): THEME LOOP

"That was wild, and so much fun! Let's give our volunteers a hand as they head back to their seats. AND let's all jump up on our feet and get ready to sing and worship God together."

SLIDE: THEME BACKGROUND

Storyteller enters as Worship Leaders exit.

SETTING UP THE STORY

STORYTELLER: "Hi, everyone. Over the past few months, we've been following God's Big Story—all the way through the entire Bible!

If you're using a timeline of story images on the wall, reference it here.

"We've talked about how God sent Jesus to be our Savior, and Jesus died on the cross for our sins. As you can imagine, this was a very sad and difficult time for Jesus' friends. Jesus had done amazing things, and the disciples really believed that He was the Son of God. But then . . . Jesus died. They thought it was all over.

"Of course, that wasn't the end of the story! Jesus came back to life, and over the next 40 days, He appeared to more than 500 of His friends and followers.

"To tell you what happened next, I'll need some help. Raise your hand if you'd like to do some acting up here on stage."

Quickly bring up several kids to play the disciples. Make sure that you choose kids with their hands raised.

A REALLY IMPORTANT JOB

STORYTELLER: (Reference the kids on stage.) "Here we have Jesus' close friends, the disciples. The disciples had been with Jesus as He performed miracles . . . healed people . . . and taught about God. They definitely knew the good news about Jesus, because they had been WITH Jesus. We'll show that by giving each of them one of these [heart/cross] stickers.

Give each of them a heart or cross sticker to wear.

"Jesus told His disciples to meet Him on a mountain in Galilee.

SLIDE: STORY SETTING 1 (MOUNTAINTOP)

"He had some important things to say to them. He said . . .

Open the Bible to Matthew 28:18-20 (NIrV) and read.

"All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. So you must go and make disciples of all nations. Baptize them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Teach them to obey everything I have commanded you. And you can be sure that I am always with you, to the very end.

"Wow. Jesus had given the disciples a really BIG job. He told them to 'go and make disciples of all nations'—in other words, to tell people everywhere about Him. Jesus told them to take His message to the whole world, because everyone needs to know!

"I've got a fun way for us to imagine what Jesus told the disciples to do. (to the kids on the stage) "Disciples, you're friends and followers of Jesus. He has just given you the incredibly important job of taking His message of love to the world.

Give a sheet of stickers to each kid on the stage.

"You can go out into the world (point to the audience) and share the good news of Jesus (hold up a page of stickers) with everyone! Stick those stickers on anyone you see. I know you don't have quite enough stickers for everyone in this room, but we can at least get the idea. Go ahead and hand out as many stickers as you can!"

AUDIO: UPBEAT INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC (I.E., THE INSTRUMENTAL VERSION OF ONE OF THE WORSHIP SONGS YOU JUST SANG)

Give the kids some time to pass out the stickers. Then call them back to the stage.

THE HELPER IS COMING

STORYTELLER: "Great job, everyone! That's what Jesus told the disciples to do: share the good news about Him with everyone in the world. But that's not as easy as just walking around and putting stickers on people, is it? I mean, think about it. The disciples lived in one small part of the world. They didn't have things like phones or the internet. They didn't have planes or cars to easily get to other places.

Hold up a sheet of stickers.

"So how could they do what Jesus asked?

"Jesus knew that He had given the disciples a big job and that they would need help. One day, while Jesus and the disciples were eating together, Jesus gave them some more instructions.

SLIDE: STORY SETTING 2 (HOUSE INTERIOR)

(to the kid volunteers) "Here disciples, you can have a seat in the house.

Set out the chairs so the kids can sit down.

"This is what Jesus said to them.

Open the Bible to Acts 1:4-5 (NIrV) and read.

"Do not leave Jerusalem. . . . Wait for the gift my Father promised. You have heard me talk about it. John baptized with water. But in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.

"Jesus' friends knew that being baptized with water was a sign of new life. It showed that the person had made a decision to change. But they had no idea what it might mean to be baptized with the Holy Spirit!

"Jesus went on to explain.

Open the Bible to Acts 1:8 (NIrV) and read.

"You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you. Then you will tell people about me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria. And you will even tell other people about me from one end of the earth to the other.

"THIS was how Jesus' followers could take His story to every person all over the world! (Hold up the sticker sheet.) Jesus wanted them to know that the Holy Spirit would help them do it."

JESUS RISES TO HEAVEN

STORYTELLER: "After Jesus had told them this, He raised up His hands and gave them a special blessing. And you'll never believe what happened next!

(to the kid volunteers) "Disciples, let me see you stand up from your chairs and look in the sky, like this.

Put your hand above your eyes and look up.

SLIDE: STORY SETTING 3 (BLUE SKY WITH CLOUDS)

"Right in front of their eyes, Jesus was lifted toward heaven! The disciples watched until a cloud hid Him from their view.

"Suddenly, the disciples noticed that two men dressed in white clothing were standing there beside them. (to the kid volunteers) Let me see you look shocked, disciples!

Do the Home Alone face with your hands on your cheeks and your mouth wide open.

"Here's what the men said.

Open the Bible to Acts 1:11 (NIrV) and read.

"Men of Galilee . . . why do you stand here looking at the sky? Jesus has been taken away from you into heaven. But he will come back in the same way you saw him go."

SLIDE: THEME BACKGROUND

WRAPPING UP THE STORY

STORYTELLER: "After this, the disciples returned to Jerusalem. Every day, they went to the temple to praise God.

(to the kid volunteers) "Disciples, let me see you celebrate and shout 'Woo-HOO!' (Pause for them to do this.) All right, you can have a seat. Thanks for your help!

Dismiss the kid volunteers to their seats.

"Jesus told the disciples that they would have the help of the Holy Spirit as they began to share the good news about Him.

"Did you know that we can share the good news of Jesus, too? Jesus gave that big job to the disciples, and it's the same big job we have today. We can talk about Jesus and share what He's done in our lives. And just as importantly, we can share His love with the people around us.

"We can live with confidence because we know that God is with us. We know that God loved us enough to send Jesus to be our Savior!

"Remember . . .

SLIDE: BOTTOM LINE

"Share God's love with others.

"Let's pray and ask God to help us do that."

SLIDE: THEME BACKGROUND

PRAY

STORYTELLER: "Dear God, thank You for showing us Your love by sending Jesus. Thank You for the way Jesus showed US how to love. We want to do what Jesus told the disciples to do: share Your love with others. Help us share the good news of Jesus everywhere we go. Thank You for letting us be part of Your Big Story! We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen."

HOST: "Jesus told His disciples that they would never be alone.

SLIDE: GOD'S BIG STORY TIMELINE SLIDE: WEEK 1 TIMELINE IMAGE

If you're making a timeline of printed images on your wall, take this moment to place today's timeline image on the clothesline.

"Of course, Jesus knew that He was about to leave and go to heaven. But before He did, He left His followers with a really important promise. He told them that God would send a helper who would always be with them. He promised that God would send the Holy Spirit.

"With the help of the Holy Spirit, Jesus' followers would be able to 'make disciples' everywhere they went. They would be able to share God's love with other people. That's what we can do, too!

SLIDE: BOTTOM LINE

"We can share God's love with others.

"That might sound like a lot. But we can have confidence because we know that God is with us! That will help us tell people about Jesus AND share God's love with the people around us. When we live with that kind of confidence, the people around us will see the way we act and the way we [Basic Truth] treat others the way we want to be treated. They might want to know more about Jesus, too.

Note: This would a great opportunity to share a personal story of a time when someone shared God's love with you or told you about Jesus.

"Let's check out our memory verse for this month, Hebrews 13:6.

SLIDE: MEMORY VERSE

"So we say with confidence, 'The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid.' (Hebrews 13:6a, NIV)

"I love that! And it's so true—God IS our Helper. God is with us, always. Let's head to Small Group now and talk about how we can **share God's love with others!"**

Dismiss kids to their small groups.
