Miracles

SCRIPTURE:

2 Kings 4:8-37

MAIN POINTS:

- Miracles will flow out of a deeper relationship with God
- Maintaining a posture of surrender and trust in God

CHALLENGE YOUTH THIS WEEKEND:

- Find ways you can maintain a posture of surrender and trust in God to create an atmosphere of faith and expectancy in our lives.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Would you rather win the lottery or live twice as long?
- Would you rather go live in the past or skip to the future?
- How does the story of the Shunammite woman in 2 Kings 4:8-37 demonstrate the importance of preparing a spiritual room for God's miracles in your life?
- How can we prepare our hearts and minds to create a space for God to work miracles in your life, based on the sermon's main point of "prepare for a burial, not a miracle" ?
- Just as the Shunammite woman prepared for the prophet Elisha, how can you create an atmosphere of faith and expectancy in your life?
- How can we maintain a posture of surrender and trust in God, even when faced with what seems like an impossible circumstances, like the Shunammite's son illustrated?
- Reflecting on the sermon's main point, "prepare for a burial, not a miracle", how can we shift our focus from seeking miracles to creating a deeper relationship with God, knowing that His miracles flow out of that connection?
