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# 1. THE BIG STORY

[TALK ABOUT GOD | BIBLE STORY REVIEW]

WHAT YOU NEED: "The Big Story Sheets" Activity Pages and coloring materials

#### WHAT YOU DO:

• Set out the sixteen pages from "The Big Story Sheets"

Activity Page.

- Set out the coloring materials.
- Instruct the kids to put the events in order.
- Invite the kids to sign their names on the "Our Small Group" sheet and add drawings or decorations to that page.
- Circle up around the sheets from "The Big Story Sheets" Activity Page.

#### WHAT YOU SAY:

"What's your favorite part of the Big Story? (Invite responses and share yours!) Sometimes, we forget that we're part of God's Big Story! All of us, the whole world and everyone in it, are part of God's big plan that **God will make** everything right in the end.

"We started with everything going right, in the Garden of Eden, and we will end with everything right again—in heaven. It's hard to imagine heaven and living with God forever. Anything that seems to take 'forever,' feels like an unpleasant thing—a dentist visit, a boring class, waiting for your family to finish talking after church. We don't really see 'lasting forever' as a good thing.

"But what if something amazing lasted forever? The best vacation you've ever been on, a bottomless ice cream cone, that perfect morning at the beach or camping in the woods, when everything seems possible. I think that's what heaven might be like.

"And nothing goes wrong there. You never oversleep, miss your bus, get bullied, eat something gross, fall down, get hurt, or fight with your siblings. All the things that go wrong here, **God will make everything right in the end."**

# 3. CARRY A TUNE [HEAR FROM GOD | MEMORY VERSE ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: Bibles

#### WHAT YOU DO:

- Split your group into smaller groups of two or three.
- Make sure each group has a Bible.
- Instruct each group to look up and read Ephesians 2:8 together with the navigation tips below.

Finding verses with a multi-age group: Guide all kids to open their Bibles to the front and find the table of contents. Hold up a Bible opened to the table of contents to show the kids what the page looks like. When the kids find the table of contents, ask a middle elementary kid (2nd–3rd grade) to find "Ephesians" in the list under "New Testament." When the kid finds Ephesians lead them to look at the page number beside the word and say it, explaining that the number tells them on what page they can find Ephesians. Ask older elementary kids (4th–5th grade) to help younger ones find the correct page in their own Bibles. When they all find Ephesians, explain that the big numbers on the page are the chapter numbers. Ask a kindergartner or 1st grader to find chapter 2, and give time for all the kids to turn the pages to find it. Explain that the small numbers are verse numbers, and ask a middle elementary kid to find verse 8 in chapter 2. Then, read the verse aloud slowly, especially for your pre-readers; or ask older elementary kids to read it to the group.

- Direct each group to come up with a song for the verse.
- Assign themes to each group:
  - Christmas tune
  - Nursery rhyme tune
  - Pop star tune
  - Chant with hand clapping and foot stomping
- Allow kids to practice for a few minutes.
- Invite the kids to perform their song for the group.

#### WHAT YOU SAY:

"This is the last week of our verse! You've done a great job of ending on a high note! Haha! Get it?

"The end of things—like the end of the month or the end of the summer, or even the end of the year—brings a lot of thoughts of finishing things, wrapping them up. What are you ending this month? What will you be starting next month? (Invite conversation.)

"Just like this month ended, and summer doesn't last forever, we can keep in mind that the ups and downs, the highs and lows of life won't last forever. We can think that the bad stuff will stick around forever and the fun stuff goes by too fast, but keep in mind that God will make everything right in the end."

#### WHAT YOU SAY:

"I'm SO THANKFUL that God gave John a special dream about heaven! Because of John's dream, we have a beautiful picture of what heaven will be like. And remembering that beautiful picture can give us hope, because we know that **God will make everything right in the end!** And the end of God's story is HEAVEN. Let's pray."

(Guide kids to say the Bottom Line when you pause where indicated. Provide help as needed. Tell kids it's okay for them to pray with their eyes open so they can see your cues or read the Bottom Line.)

"Dear God, thank You so much for heaven. (Pause for God will make everything right in the end.) You will wipe away every tear from our eyes. (Pause.) There will be no more death. (Pause.) No more sadness. (Pause.) No more crying or pain. (Pause.) You are making everything new. (Pause.) Thank You, Lord, that in heaven we will SEE YOUR FACE! (Pause.) We will live with you FOREVER! (Pause.) We love You SO MUCH, Lord. Amen."

As adults arrive to pick up, encourage kids to share today's Bottom Line. **God** will make everything right in the end.
