PERSPECTIVE OF PRAISE

SCRIPTURE:

Philippians 4:4-6 Philippians 1 Acts 16

MAIN POINTS:

- Mistakes we make:
 - We need to have a perspective of praise, not a perspective of praise
 - Your present imprisonment, isn't your permanent residence
 - Praise for WHO not WHAT

CHALLENGE YOUTH THIS WEEKEND:

 When you face a difficult time this week, take time to praise God in the midst of it.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Can you think of a funny situation where rejoicing seems difficult? How can we maintain a perspective of praise even in challenging moments?
- Describe a time when your perspective influenced how you handled a tough situation. How can we adopt Paul's perspective of praise during hardships?
- Why do you think Paul and Silas praised God in prison? How can their example inspire us to find reasons to praise even when life is hard?
- Explain the difference between joy and happiness.
 How does focusing on Jesus' sacrifice help us find joy in tough times?
- Discuss the idea that Jesus holds the power. How does this perspective affect how we face difficulties? How can we maintain a hopeful outlook through Jesus' example?
