SCRIPTURE:

John 8:12

Matthew 5:14

MAIN POINTS:

- Mistakes we make:
 - You were created to receive light
 - You were created to reflect light

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What do you think Jesus meant when He said, "I am the light of world"? How does following Him prevent us from walking in darkness, according to John 8:12?
- In Matthew 5:14-15, Jesus tells us that we are the light of the world. What does it mean to be a "city set on a hill" in our daily lives? How can we avoid hiding our light from others?
- How does the presence of light in darkness impact our perspective and choices in life? Can you share a personal experience when encountering light made a significant difference in your life?
- Discuss the idea that Jesus doesn't challenge us to become the light of the world but says we already are. What does this mean for us as Christians? How can we reflect God's light to others effectively?
- Pastor Jordan mentioned that our shining isn't about showing how good we are but how good God is. How can we ensure that our actions and character reflect this purpose? Share examples of how you've seen someone do this effectively.
- What principal steps can we take as a group to shine brighter in our communities and among our friends and family? Brainstorm ideas and discuss how you can support each other in living our your role as lights in this world.
