BIBLE STORY

Happy Birthday, Jesus!

HAPPY BIRTHDAY, JESUS! LUKE 1:26-33, 38; 2:1-21

MEMORY VERSE

"God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son."

JOHN 3:16, GNT

KEY QUESTION

How do we know God loves us?

BOTTOM LINE

God gave us Jesus.

BASIC TRUTH

God loves me.

LARGE GROUP

ENGAGE CHILDREN'S HEARTS THROUGH A DYNAMIC AND INTERACTIVE WORSHIP, BIBLE STORY, AND PRAYER EXPERIENCE IN A LARGE GROUP SETTING.

WORSHIP

WHAT YOU NEED: "Memory Verse Card" from Week One in Bible; instruments or music player; this month's worship song, "Silent Night," included in your monthly files; and "Happy Birthday Jesus," available on OrangeKidsMusic.com; Optional Dance Moves Videos for "Silent Night," available in the Media Package if you subscribe or from OrangeKidsMusic.com, and "Happy Birthday Jesus," available from OrangeKidsMusic.com

Worship Leader enters.

WORSHIP LEADER: "Friends, I'm SO excited to see you today! My name is [your name]. Raise your hand if you're SO excited it's almost Christmas. Me, too! I'm so excited to celebrate Jesus' birthday! God gave us Jesus to show how much God loves us! **How do you know God loves you?"**

CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER: "God gave us Jesus."

WORSHIP LEADER: "You've got it! Stand up on your feet and sing this out with me.

Lead children in singing "Silent Night," this month's worship song.

"God loves us so much that He gave us Jesus! The Bible teaches us that 'God (flat hand with thumb to forehead, pull down) loved the world (cross arms over chest) so much (pull hands away from each other) that he gave his only Son,' (rock arms like a baby) John 3:16. (Open hands like a book.) Let's say that together.

Lead children to say the memory verse with the motions.

"God loves you and God loves me SO much that God gave us Jesus! **How do we know God loves us?"**

CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER: "God gave us Jesus."

WORSHIP LEADER: "Yes! Jesus is God's Son, and we celebrate Jesus' birthday on Christmas. Let's celebrate! Sing this out with me.

Lead children in singing "Happy Birthday, Jesus."

"As we celebrate Christmas with family and friends, let's tell everyone about what God has done! **God gave us Jesus!**



FOUR
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10 MINUTES

"Thanks for worshipping with me today! **[Transition]** And now it's time to turn around, sit down, and shake the wiggles out (wiggle hands) so we can hear (cup hands behind ears) what the story's all about!"

Host enters as Worship Leader exits.

INTRO SKETCH

WHAT YOU NEED: Sheet cakes; cake boards or platters; frosting; angel tree topper or other angel decoration; silver sprinkles; small baby decoration; shredded wheat cereal; green sprinkles; large marshmallows; candy canes; resealable plastic bag; a box; a table; and fun Christmas sweater, headband, or necklace from previous weeks; Optional dummy cakes or foam blocks in place of sheet cakes

Preset the table and cakes in the center of the storytelling area, behind the Christmas Story train.

Host enters.

HOST: "Oh, hi friends! Welcome to [your environment or story time]! I'm [your name]! Do you know what special day we're celebrating? (*Pause.*) Shout it out if you know. (*Pause.*) Yes! Christmas! Christmas is when we celebrate Jesus' birthday! And I'm making some awesome birthday cakes to say 'HAPPY BIRTHDAY' to Jesus!

"All that's left to do is decorate. I brought this bag of decorations. Let's see what we can find.

Pull out angel decoration.

"Look! It's like the angel who told Mary she would have Baby Jesus!

Place the angel on the first cake then add silver sprinkles.

"Next, some silver sprinkles. Perfect! Let's do another!

Pull out a small baby decoration.

"This can be Baby Jesus! But what about some hay for the manger?

Pull out the bag of shredded wheat cereal.

"Ah-ha! Cereal that looks just like hay! I can use it to make the manger where Baby Jesus slept!

Put the shredded cereal on the second cake then place the baby on the hay.

"I'll just tuck Baby Jesus in on the comfy hay. (Pause.) This is looking so good! (Pause.) I wonder if there's anything I can use for green grass. We have to have green grass for the shepherds and their sheep.

Pull out green sprinkles, marshmallows, and candy canes.

"WOW! Look! I can use green sprinkles for grass.



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10 MINUTES

Pour green sprinkles on the third cake.

"Marshmallows for sheep.

Put marshmallows on cake.

"And candy canes for shepherds. The candy canes look kind of like the sticks the shepherds carried.

Put candy canes on the cake.

"There! All I need now are some birthday candles. What do you think? Pretty cool, right?

"Our Bible story is all about Jesus' birthday! Enjoy the story while I go look for some birthday candles. Bye!"

Storyteller enters as Host exits.

STORY

WHAT YOU NEED: "Birthday Cake" Activity Page; cardstock; cardboard box; brightly colored butcher paper in various colors or paint and paintbrushes; construction paper; tinsel garland; scissors; packaging tape; utility knife; party horn or blow-out; confetti; bowl; Bible; and train whistle, train engineer costume, Christmas story train engine, and "Mary and Angel," "Joseph and Mary on Donkey," "Baby Jesus" and "Shepherd and Sheep" train cars from previous weeks; Optional Story Images and cardstock

Preset the Christmas Story train in the storytelling area.

Storyteller enters dressed like a train engineer, carrying a train whistle and Bible.

STORYTELLER: "Hello, friends! I'm [your name], and I can't wait to tell you a true story from the Bible.

Open Bible for children to see, then set it down.

"And our Christmas train is going to help us learn about the true story of Christmas! Are you ready for a story? (*Listen for response*.) Fantastic! When I blow my whistle, I want everyone to say, 'ALL ABOARD!' Get ready!"

Blow train whistle.

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "ALL ABOARD!"

Kneel next to the "Angel and Mary" train car.

STORYTELLER: "The true story of Christmas begins with a girl named Mary.

Point to Mary in the picture on the train car.



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"God gave Mary an important message by sending an angel!

Put on angel wings.

(Option: Display Story Image W4 01)

"The angel gave Mary a VERY important message. Mary was surprised and a little afraid when she saw the angel. But the angel said, 'Do not be afraid, Mary! God says you are going to have a baby and you will call Him Jesus.'

"WOW! That IS a very important message! Mary was going to have a baby! And not just any baby. Mary was going to have Jesus! (*Pause*.) Jesus is special because Jesus is God's Son!

Pick up confetti from train car and throw it in the air.

"Hooray for Jesus!

"Not long after that, Joseph and Mary . . .

Lift the flaps on the "Joseph and Mary" train car to reveal Joseph and Mary.

(Option: Display Story Image W4 02)

"... had to travel to a town called Bethlehem. Did Mary and Joseph stay in a big fancy castle, or did they stay in a stable where animals live? (*Pause*.) Yes, Mary and Joseph stayed in a stable where animals live.

Pull animal cutouts from "Baby Jesus" train car and slide craft sticks into slits.

"Because there were no rooms anywhere else. And that's where Baby Jesus was born!

(Option: Display Story Image W4 03)

"On the same day Jesus was born, there were shepherds out in a field taking care of their . . . ?

Point to the shepherds and sheep on the "Shepherds and Sheep" train car.

"Right again! The shepherds were taking care of their sheep! While the shepherds were watching their sheep, God sent an angel to tell them that Jesus had been born.

Pull angel garland on dowels from the "Shepherd and Sheep" train car, and place dowels in holes on the top flap to reveal angel garland.

(Option: Display Story Image W4 04)

"At first, the shepherds were afraid, but the angel told them, 'Don't be afraid! God's Son, Jesus, has been born!' Then the shepherds got excited. What did the shepherds do? (*Pause*.)

Run in place really fast.



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"Yes! Stand up and run in place with me.

Lead children to run in place really fast.

"Great job! You can sit down. The shepherds ran as fast as they could to find Baby Jesus!

(Option: Display Story Image W4 05)

"When the shepherds got to the stable, they saw Mary and Joseph and Baby Jesus, just like the angel said they would.

"And that is why we celebrate Christmas! Christmas is when **God gave us Jesus.** It's Jesus' birthday!

Pull party horn/blow-out from "Birthday Cake" train car and blow party horn/blow-out.

"Happy birthday, Jesus! (Pause.) Hey! Let's all sing 'Happy Birthday' to Jesus! Stand up, and let's sing!"

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "Happy birthday to you! Happy birthday to you! Happy birthday, dear Jesus. Happy birthday to you!"

Blow party horn/blow-out and toss confetti.

STORYTELLER: "Happy birthday, Jesus! Yay, Jesus! Woo-hoo! God loves us so much that **God gave us Jesus!** And Christmas is when we celebrate Jesus' birthday!

"Thanks for singing with me. You can sit back down.

"Now that you know Christmas is all about when God gave us Jesus, if anyone ever asks, 'How do we know God loves us?', all you have to say is 'God gave us Jesus!' How do we know God loves us?"

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "God gave us Jesus!"

STORYTELLER: "One more time for Jesus' birthday! How do we know God loves us?"

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "God gave us Jesus!"

STORYTELLER: "Yay! **God gave us Jesus! [Transition]** Our story time is over (*pick up and close Bible*), but we're not through. Let's talk to God because God loves you!"

PRAYER

STORYTELLER: "Dear God, we want to say, 'Happy birthday' to Jesus today! Thank You for loving us so much that You sent Your Son to be our friend forever. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, we pray, amen.

"Merry Christmas, everyone! Bye!"

Host enters as Storyteller exits, carrying Bible.

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OUTRO SKETCH

WHAT YOU NEED: Birthday candles

Host enters, carrying birthday candles.

HOST: "Wow! Christmas is all about Jesus's birthday! God loves us so much that He gave us Jesus! I think I (point to self) got the story. Did you (point to children) get it? If you did, say, 'Got it!' Get it?" (Cup one hand behind ear.)

CHILDREN AND HOST: "Got it!"

HOST: (Give two thumbs-up.) "Good!

"I think our train birthday cake is a fun way to say, 'Happy birthday' to Jesus! All I have to do is put the birthday candles on it!

Put a few candles on the cake.

"Now we're ready to say, 'Happy birthday' to Jesus! Can you say, 'Happy birthday' to Jesus with me? (*Pause.*) One, two, three."

CHILDREN AND HOST: "Happy birthday, Jesus!"

HOST: "Merry Christmas, everyone! **[Transition]** And now it's time for more Bible fun. There's more to learn. Come on, everyone!"

Host dismisses small groups and exits.
