Heart Prep

SCRIPTURE:

Zechariah 9:9

Matthew 21:1-11

Mark 11:1-11

Luke 19:28-44

John 12:12-19

MAIN POINTS:

- On Palm Sunday, the people of Jerusalem came out to welcome Jesus as the Messiah, the deliverer, the King.
- It was the beginning of the end of Jesus' life. This began "Holy Week" and for us, we should take this time to prepare our hearts for Easter and what it means for us.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- How was spring break last week?
- What is "Palm Sunday"?
- What is something that stood out to you in TJ's message?
- What are some ways that you "betray" Jesus?
- What can you do this week to prepare your heart for Easter and the good news that comes with that?
- What can your Tribe do to support each other to prepare our hearts this week?

CHALLENGE TO YOUTH

There were many people who shouted "Hosanna!" But those same people greeting Jesus, exalting and praising Him, would be shouting "Crucify him" one week later. Many of us respond with "How could they do that? Praise him on Sunday and then a few days later, choose to betray him?" I have one question ... Don't we do that at times? Show up to church and praise the name of Jesus, but a few days later at school, work, sports, or hanging out with friends choose to betray him? What would it look like for us to take this Palm Sunday, the beginning of a Holy Week, and prepare our hearts for real dedication, commitment and praise to Jesus for lasting praise not instant betrayal?
