an activity that lets preschoolers pretend, imagine, and role play to enhance their learning



3. HOW MANY?

WHAT YOU DO:

and see them self

WHAT YOU NEED: Preschool-safe hand held mirror (resource closset)

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Allow each kid to hold up Mirror

and count with you to find the answers to the "how had grouted to the start of the second the children to count while looking in the mirror.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Introduce the Bible Story.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, come sit here in front of the mirror. Can everyone see themselves? Great!"

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "Take a look in the mirror and tell me, how many eyes do you have? Carefully point to your eyes and count with me. One, two! You have two eyes! How many noses do you have? Carefully point to your nose and count with me. One! You have one nose. How many mouths do you have? Carefully point to your mouth and count with me. One! You have one mouth. How many ears do you have? Carefully point to your ears and count with me. One, two! You have two ears. How many tummies do you have? Carefully point to your tummies and count with me. One! You have one tummy. How many hands do you have? Hold your hands up and count with me. One, two! You have two hands. How many hairs are on your head? Can you count each one? (*Pause.*) You have so many hairs on your head it would be hard to count every single one!"

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Did you know that God knows how many hairs are on your head? It's true! We'll hear all about it in our Bible Story today. Let's go!"

TRANSITION: Move to Worship and Story by continuing to count the wonderful things God made as they travel. You can repeat some of the things from the activity.

3. LOOK UNDER THE HEART [LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: Painter's tape, red construction paper, scissors, and preschool-safe floor-length mirror

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Set a mirror in an open area of

the room. Create a path to the mirror with tape. Cut a large heart from the construction paper. Apply tape to the top of the heart and attach to the mirror at child's height.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage children to walk the path, lift the heart, and say: "I am important to God."

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Review the Bottom Line.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Friends! Come stand over here with me at this tape line."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "Look, it's a path for us to follow. Walk with me. (Pause.) [Child's name], what do you see? (Pause.) A heart! Look under the heart who do you see? (Pause.) It's you! [Child's name], say: 'I am important to God!' Great job! Next friend, walk the path! (Continue with each child.) Friends, each one of you is important to God and God made each of you WONDERFUL!"

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Today in our Bible Story, we learned that God knows everything about you! God knows when you are happy, and when you are sad. God even knows how many hairs are on your head! God knows everything about you and me because we are important to God. God made you wonderful, and God made me wonderful! Who made you wonderful? God made me wonderful."



BEFORE THE ACTIVITY:

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage children to color and draw there face

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, come sit at the table with me. I have something super-fun for us to do today!"

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Look at how God made you beautiful and wonderfully made

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, in our Bible Story, we learned that God made you as wonderful and amazing as the picture you made today! God knows the number of hairs on your head! Isn't that amazing? God knows everything about you because you are important to God. God made you wonderful! Who made you wonderful? God made me wonderful."

MADE TO MOVE

1. AMAZING AND WONDERFUL [HEAR FROM GOD | MEMORY VERSE REVIEW] WHAT YOU NEED: Parachute, and pom-poms or foam hearts

BIBLE STORY

I am important to God.

KEY QUESTION

Who made you wonderful?

BOTTOM LINE

God made me wonderful.

BASIC TRUTH

God made me.

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Spread the parachute on the floor of the open activity area. Place pom-poms/foam hearts on top of the parachute. Encourage the children to sit around the parachute. Review the Memory Verse and motions.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Say the Memory Verse with the children and encourage them to lift the parachute high when they say: "amazing and wonderful." Repeat as desired.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Say the Memory Verse and motions one last time, and review the Bottom Line.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, come sit with me around this parachute. Let's practice our Memory Verse and motions together. Ready? 'How you (point up) made me (point to self) is amazing and wonderful,' (push hands up twice) Psalm 139:14. (Open hands like a book.) Great job, friends!"

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "Grab hold of the parachute with both hands, and we'll say our verse again. This time, when we say the words AMAZING and WONDERFUL, we are going to lift our parachute high into the air. Are we all ready? (Pause.) Okay! 'How you made me is amazing (lift the parachute and bring it back down) and wonderful.' (Lift the parachute and bring it back down.) Let's do that again! 'How you made me is amazing (lift the parachute and bring it back down) and wonderful.' (Lift the parachute and bring it back down.) So fun, friends!" (Repeat as desired.)

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Let's say our verse one more time with the motions. 'How you (point up) made me (point to self) is amazing and wonderful,' (push hands up twice) Psalm 139:14. (Open hands like a book.) Who made you wonderful? God made me wonderful!"
